## **MATERIALS AND TOOLS:**

- Yarn: Yarn Art Jeans 28 grafit, Yarn Art Jeans 62 white, Catania 437 dark beige
  - Black, pink and white embroidery thread
  - 2,2/2.5 mm crochet hook
  - Safety eyes black 10 mm
  - Soft stuffing
  - stitch maker
  - scissors
  - knitting needles

Finished size - about 23 cm if using similar yarn.

## **ABBREVIATIONS:**

- ch - chain
- R - round
- st - stitch
- sc - single crochet
- dc - double crochet
- hdc - half double crochet
- flo - front loop only
- sl st - slip stitch
- dcdec - double crochet two together
- blo - back loop only
- dec- decrease
- inc- increase
- bo - bobble stitch

## **NOTES:**

- Work in a continuous spiral unless otherwise stated. Do not join rounds.
- Use a stitch marker or a piece of yarn to mark the beginning of round.
- Change yarn always in the last step of the last stitch.
- Stuff your amigurumi as you go.
- Fasten off your work with needle join and you'll get a neat result.

## EYE PATCHES X2

### Grafit

R1: ch9, start from the second ch from hook: 7sc, 3sc in the last st, turn and continue on the other side: 6sc, 3sc in the last st. (19)

R2: 1sc, 6inc, 1sc, 2inc, 3dec, 1sc, 2inc, sl st (26)

*Fasten off, cut the yarn leaving long tail for sewing. Attach safety eyes in the eye patches.*



## MUZZLE

### White

R1: magic circle with 6st (6)

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: 1sc, inc [x6] (18)

R4: 2sc, inc [x6] (24)

R5: 3inc, 9sc [x2] (30)

R6-7: 1sc in each st (30)

*Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving long tail for sewing.*



## HEAD

### White

R1: magic circle with 6st (6)

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: 1sc, inc [x6] (18)

R4: 2sc, inc [x6] (24)

R5: 3sc, inc [x6] (30)

R6: 4sc, inc [x6] (36)

R7: 5sc, inc [x6] (42)

R8: 6sc, inc [x6] (48)

R9: 7sc, inc [x6] (54)

R10: 8sc, inc [x6] (60)

R11-21: 1sc in each st (60)

R22: 8sc, dec [x6] (54)

R23: 7sc, dec [x6] (48)

R24: 6sc, dec [x6] (42)

R25: 5sc, dec [x6] (36)

R26: 4sc, dec [x6] (30)



*Take eye patches and place them on the head.*

*Insert safety eyes between R17-18. Leaving distance 12-13 st between eyes.*

*Look at the picture.*

*Stuff the head with fiberfill and continue adding stuffing as the work progresses.*

*Sew the muzzle on the head between eyes over rounds 16-25, Stuff the muzzle with fiberfill before closing the hole.*

*Sew the eye patches around the muzzle.*

R27: 3sc, dec [x6] (24)

R28: 2sc, dec [x6] (18)

*Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving long tail for sewing.*

## EARS x2

### Grafit

R1: magic circle with 6st (6)

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: 1sc, inc [x6] (18)

R4: 1sc in each st (18)

R5: 1sc, dec [x6] (12)

R6: 1sc in each st (12)



*Fasten off. Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing. Fold in half. Sew the ears to the head on rounds 6-10. Do not stuff.*



Embroider the details of the face with black, pink and white yarn as shown on the pictures.





## LEGS AND BODY

*Grafit and white*

**Legs x2**

**Start with grafit yarn:**

R1: magic circle with 6st (6)

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: 1sc, inc [x6] (18)

R4: 1sc in each st (18)

R5: 2sc, inc [x6] (24)

R6-7: 1sc in each st (24)

R8: 6dec, 12sc (18)

R9: 3dec, 12sc (15)

R10-12: 1sc in each st (15)

R13: 1sc in each st (15) + 2sc more

*(so that the legs point inwards)*

*Stuff the legs. End with sl st. Cut the yarn.*



**Crochet the second leg in the same way, after R13 change to white yarn:**

R14: ch5 and join to the first leg with a sc (this counts as the 1st of the following 15sc), 15sc around first leg, 5sc (in the 5ch), 15sc around second leg. (40) + make additional 12sc - so as to start a new round from the side.

*This is the new beginning of your next rounds.*

R15: 9sc, inc [x4] (44)

R16: 10sc, inc [x4] (48)

R17: 1sc in each st (48)  
R18: 7sc, inc [x6] (54)  
R19: 26sc, inc [x2] (56)  
R20-25: 1sc in each st (56)  
R26: 26sc, dec [x2] (54)  
R27: 1sc in each st (54)  
R28: 7sc, dec [x6] (48)  
R29: 1sc in each st (48)  
R30: 6sc, dec [x6] (42)

***Change to grafit yarn:***

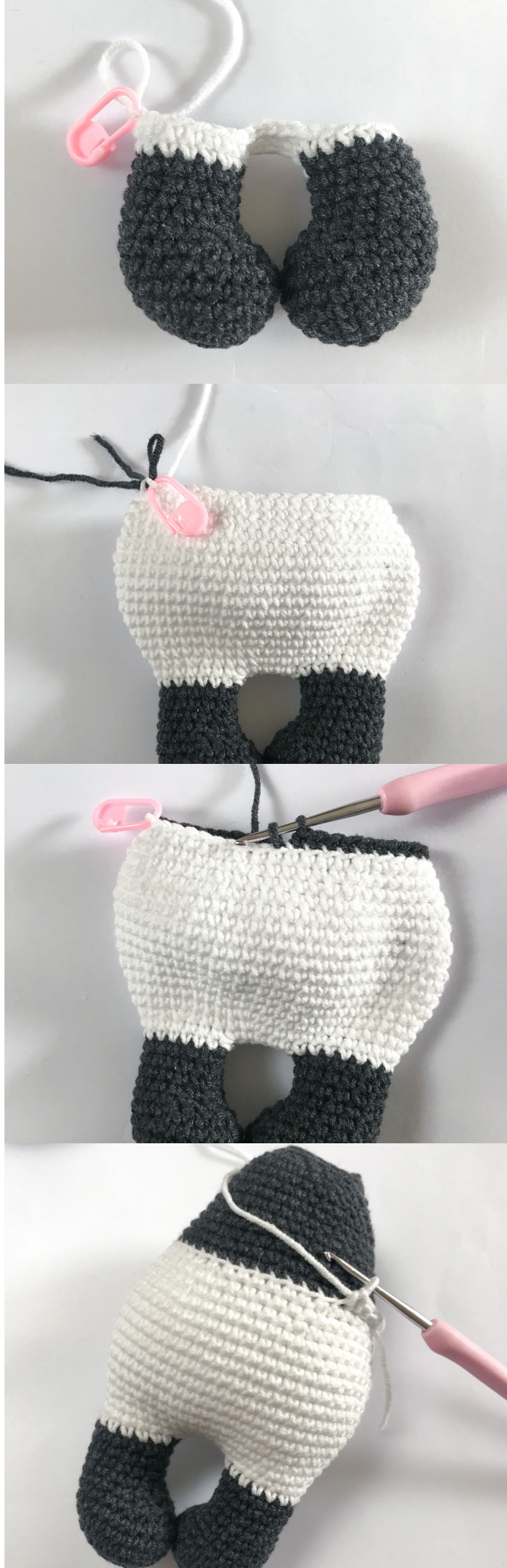
R31: blo 1sc in each st (42)  
R32: dec, 19sc [x2] (40)  
R33: 1sc in each st (40)

*Stuff the body with fiberfill and continue adding stuffing as the work progresses.*

R34: dec, 18sc [x2] (38)  
R35: 1sc in each st (38)  
R36: dec, 17sc [x2] (36)  
R37: 1sc in each st (36)  
R38: dec, 16sc [x2] (34)  
R39: dec, 15sc [x2] (32)  
R40: dec, 14sc [x2] (30)  
R41: dec, 3sc [x6] (24)  
R42: dec, 2sc [x6] (18)  
R43: blo 1sc in each st (18)

*Cut the yarn and fasten off your work.*

*Go back to R31 and work with front loops of it with white yarn: 1sc in each st, sl st (42)*





## COLLAR

*Dark beige*

*Attach yarn first stitch on the R43 and work with front loops of it:*

R1: ch2(count as 1dc), 3dc in each st, sl st (54)

R2: ch2, 2dc in each st, sl st (108)

R3: 1sc in each st, sl st (108)

*Cut the yarn and fasten off your work.*

*Sew the body to the head.*



## ARMS x2

*Grafit*

R1: magic circle with 6st (6)

R2: 6inc (12)

R3-5: 1sc in each st (12)

R6: 4sc, dec [x2] (10)

R7-20: 1sc in each st (10)

*Stuff the arms with fiberfill.*

R21: 5sc through both sides to the end (5)

*Cut the yarn leaving a long tail for sewing.*

*Sew the arms to the body.*



## TAIL

### *Grafit*

Insert the yarn about R25 (body) in the center - between the legs and crochet:  
ch3, 1 bo (bobble stitch), sl st.

Cut the yarn and fasten off your work.
