Frankenstein



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PATTERN NOTE

- Instructions are written in rounds & row, using US terminology.
- Make invisible decrease stitches to have a better result.
- Add toy stuffing according to instruction of each part.
- Stitches should be close together so that when the finished toy is stuffed, the stuffing does not come out through gaps in the stitches.
- Changing color and joining yarn:
 Work in the previous color (or yarn)
 until two loops of the last stitch
 remain on the hook. Use the new
 color (or yarn) to complete the stitch.
 Continue working with the new color
 (or yarn) as before. Then knot both
 yarns to make sure the stitch stays
 tight.

MATERIALS

- (3/0) 2.3 mm crochet hook.
- 6mm black beads or toy safety eyes.
- · Needle for sewing.
- Toy stuffing (fiberfill).
- Stitch marker.
- Scissors.
- Sport yarn (160m/50gr)

I have used Yarnart Jeans with the colors:

- 71 (brown)
- 40 (dark brown)
- 29 (green)
- 49 (gray)
- 53 (black)

ABBREVIATIONS

- st stitch
- · ch chain
- slst slip stitch
- sc single crochet
- · hdc half double crochet
- dc double crochet
- trc treble crochet
- inc increase
- dec decrease
- BLO back loop only
- FLO front loop only
- [...] number of stitches you should have at the end of each round.

<u>Finished size:</u> the finished toy is approximately 18cm high.

INSTRUCTIONS

HEAD

Start in black yarn.

Rnd 1: start 7 sc in a magic ring [7]

Rnd 2: inc in all 7 st [14]

Rnd 3: (sc in next st, inc in next st) repeat 7 times [21]

Rnd 4: (sc in next 2 st, inc in next st) repeat 7 times [28]

Rnd 5: sc in next st, inc in next st, (sc in next 3 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times, sc in next

2 st [35]

Rnd 6: (sc in next 4 st, inc in next st) repeat 7 times [42]

Rnd 7: sc in next 2 st, inc in next st, (sc in next 5 st, inc in next st) repeat 6 times, sc in

next 3 st [49]

Rnd 8: sc in all 49 st [49]

Rnd 9: (sc in next 6 st, inc in next st) repeat 7 times [56]

Rnd 10: sc in all 56 st [56]

Change to green yarn.

Rnd 11: BLO sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 12 - 14: sc in all 56 st [56]

Rnd 15: (sc in next 7 st, inc in next st) repeat 7 times [63]

Rnd 16: sc in all 63 st [63]

Rnd 17: (sc in next 20 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [66]

Rnd 18 - 21: sc in all 66 st [66]

Rnd 22: (sc in next 9 st, dec) repeat 6 times [60]

Rnd 23: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 10 times [50]

Rnd 24: (sc in next 3 st, dec) repeat 10 times [40]

Rnd 25: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 10 times [30]

Insert the safety eyes between rounds 17 and 18, 11 stitches apart.

Fasten off. Stuff the head firmly with fiberfill.

Embroider the scars with black yarn.

*Make the hair: Turn the head, working in the FLO of round 11, attach black yarn: slst, (ch 3, trc in next st, slst in next 3 st) repeat 13 times, ch 3, trc in next st, slst in next 2 st [56] Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail. Apply fabric glue or sew the hair to the head.





SCREWS

Start in gray yarn.

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

Rnd 2 - 3: sc in all 6 st [6]

SIst in next st. Fasten off, leaving the yarn tail. Sew the screw between rounds 19 and 22 in both side of the head.



LEG

LEFT LEG

Start in brown yarn.

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3: 3 sc in next st, sc in next 4 st, (3 sc in next st) repeat 2 times, sc in next 4 st, 3 sc in next st [20]

Rnd 4: inc in next st, sc in next 8 st, inc in next 2 st, sc in next 8 st, inc in next st [24]

Rnd 5: BLO sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 6 - 7: sc in all 24 st [24]

Rnd 8: sc in next 8 st, 4 dec, sc in next 8 st [20]

Rnd 9: sc in next 6 st, 4 dec, sc in next 6 st [16]

Rnd 10: sc in all 16 st [16]

Change to green yarn.

Rnd 11: BLO sc in all 16 st [16]

Rnd 12 - 14: sc in all 16 st [16]

Change to dark brown yarn.

Rnd 15: sc in all 16 st [16]

Rnd 16: BLO sc in next 3 st, inc in next st, sc in next 8 st, inc in next st, sc in next 3 st [18]

Rnd 17 - 21: sc in all 18 st [18]

Rnd 22: sc in next 14 st.

SIst in next st. Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail. Stuff the left leg firmly with fiberfill.

*Make the boot fringe: Turn the leg, working in the FLO of round 11, attach brown yarn: (slst) repeat 16 times.

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.


*Make the trousers fringe: Working in the FLO of round 16. Put a stitch marker in the middle of the left side of the leg. Attach dark brown yarn at this marked stitch:

Rnd 1: ch 1, sc in next 15 st, turn [15]

Rnd 2: ch 1, sc in next 15 st [15]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.







RIGHT LEG

Rnd 1 - 21: repeat the instructions for the left leg.

Rnd 22: sc in all 18 st [18]

Then continue sc in next 5 st.

Leave the remaining stitches unworked. Stuff the right leg firmly with fiberfill. Do not fasten off and continue working the body.


*Make the trousers fringe: Working in the FLO of round 16. Put a stitch marker in the middle of the right side of the leg. Attach dark brown yarn at this marked stitch:

Rnd 1: ch 1, sc in next 15 st, turn [15]

Rnd 2: ch 1, sc in next 15 st [15]

Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.







BODY

Continue in dark brown yarn.

Rnd 23: ch 3, skip first st from the slst at the end of the left leg, sc in next 18 st around the left leg, sc in one edge of next 3 ch, sc in next 18 st around the right leg, sc in the unworked edge of next 3 ch [42]

Rnd 24: (sc in next 13 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times [45]

Rnd 25: sc in all 45 st [45]

Rnd 26: (sc in next 14 st, inc in next st) repeat 3 times

[48]

Rnd 27 - 29: sc in all 48 st [48]

Change to gray yarn.

Rnd 30: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 31 - 33: sc in all 48 st [48]

Rnd 34: (sc in next 6 st, dec) repeat 6 times [42]

Rnd 35 - 37: sc in all 42 st [42]

Rnd 38: (sc in next 5 st, dec) repeat 6 times [36]

Rnd 39 - 40: sc in all 36 st [36]

Rnd 41: (sc in next 4 st, dec) repeat 6 times [30]

Rnd 42: sc in all 30 st [30]

Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing. Stuff the body firmly with fiberfill. Pin and sew the head to the body.





ARM

Make 2, start in green yarn.

Rnd 1: start 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

Rnd 2: inc in all 6 st [12]

Rnd 3 - 4: sc in all 12 st [12]

Rnd 5: (sc in next 2 st, dec) repeat 3 times [9]

Rnd 6: sc in all 9 st [9] Change to gray yarn.

Rnd 7 - 16: sc in all 9 st [9]

Stuff the arms slightly with fiberfill. Flatten the opening of the arm and sew through both layers to close the opening. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing. Pin and sew the arm and in both side of the body.



VEST

Start in brown yarn.

Chain 43. Skip the first chain on the hook.

Rnd 1: hdc in next 42 ch, turn [42]

Rnd 2: ch 1, hdc in next 42 ch, turn [42]

Rnd 3: ch 2, dc in next 7 st, ch 3, skip 5 st, dc in next 18 st, ch 3, skip 5 st, dc in next 7 st,

turn [42]

Rnd 4 - 8: ch 2, dc in next 40 st, turn [40] Fasten off and weave in the yarn tail.





Use powder blush for the cheek.
