



# Free Tutorial





## MATERIALS:

Yarn and compatible crochet hook  
Embroidery thread  
Tapestry needle  
Scissors  
Safety pin or base for button/pin  
Craft glue

## ABBREVIATIONS:

rnd: round  
slst: slip stitch  
sc: single crochet  
inc: increase  
dec: decrease  
ch: chain  
BLO: work in back loops only

Important! You won't need to use stuffing in any of the pieces.







# Daisy

## Center

Using mustard

1 rnd – 8sc in the magic ring (8)

The next rounds should all be worked

2 rnd – inc around (16)

3 rnd – (1sc, 1inc) x8 (24)

4 rnd – (2sc, 1inc) x8 (32)

5 rnd – sc around (32)

Leave a long tail for closing.



## Petals (x4)

Using white or off-white

1 rnd – 6sc in the magic ring (6)

2 rnd – (1sc, 1inc) x3 (9)

3 rnd – (2sc, 1inc) x3 (12)

4-6 rnd – sc around (12)

7 rnd – (2sc, 1dec) x3 (9)

8 rnd – (1sc, 1dec) x3 (6)

Fold and close the opening with 3sc,  
fasten off.



Now you are going to close the center and group the petals to finish the flower. Fold the center in half and make 2 slst going through both sides of the piece, in the corresponding front and back stitches of the center at the same time. Now take the first petal and position it between the fold of the center and make 3 slst, going through all three layers, the front stitches of the center, the petal stitches, and the back stitches of the center. Repeat the same process with the other 3 petals and finish by closing the center with 2 slst. Fasten off.







To create a cute finish on the center, join mustard yarn on the first loop left on round 2 and work: [1ch, 1slst] in every loop around.



## Leaf

- 1 rnd – 8sc in the magic ring (8)
- 2 rnd – inc around (16)
- 3 rnd – (1sc, 1inc) x8 (24)
- 4 rnd – (2sc, 1inc) x8 (32)
- 5-10 rnd – sc around (32)
- 11 rnd – (1dec, 14sc) x2 (30)
- 12 rnd – sc around (30)
- 13 rnd – (1dec, 13sc) x2 (28)
- 14 rnd – (1dec, 12sc) x2 (26)
- 15 rnd – 1dec, 9sc, 2dec, 9sc, 1dec (22)
- 16 rnd – 9sc, 2dec, 10sc (20)
- 17 rnd – 8sc, 2dec, 8sc (18)
- 18 rnd – (4sc, 1dec) x3 (15)
- 19 rnd – (3sc, 1dec) x3 (12)
- 20 rnd – (2sc, 1dec) x3 (9)
- 21 rnd – (1sc, 1dec) x3 (6)
- 22 rnd – sc around (6)

Close with a tapestry needle and fasten off. Use embroidery thread to make the central and secondary veins of the leaf.







# Mini Bee

Using yellow and brown

Start with yellow

1 rnd – 4sc in the magic ring (4)

2 rnd – (1sc, 1inc) x2 (6)

Change to brown

3 rnd – sc around (6)

Change to yellow

4 rnd – sc around (6)

Change to brown

5 rnd – sc around (6)

6 rnd – (1sc, 1dec) x2 (4)

Close the opening with a tapestry needle.

## ***Wings (make 2)***

Work 4sc in the magic ring. Don't close the ring. Sew both pieces on the bee's back.

Using embroidery thread, make French knots for the eyes and sew the bee on the finished leaf. Sew or glue the daisy and the leaf on a button base or attach them to a safety pin.
