height aprox. 5,5 inch/14 cm if using sport weight yarn

Hello!

First of all:

- This pattern use US terms
- Using sport weight yarn on a C/2 (2.5 mm) crochet hook, the amigurumi will measure 5,5 inch (14 cm) total.
- You crochet continuously in a spiral. You don't have to close each round with a slip sitch.

Materials

- sport weight yarn in **gray**
- a bit of sport weight yarn in off-white for the tusks
- C/2 (2.5 mm) crochet hook
- brown embroidery thread
- fiberfill
- a pair of safety eyes (6 mm)
- tapestry needle, stitch marker, scissors...





Abbreviations

ch: chain stich
dec: decrease
inc: increase
rnd(s): round(s)

sc: single crochet

sc-BLO: single crochet through back loop only

slst: slip stich
st(s): stich(es)





rnd. sts. 11. 17 sc, inc, 2 sc, inc, 24 sc, (inc, 2 sc)x2, inc, 7 sc [64] **12.** 48 sc, (inc, 3 sc)x2, inc, 7 sc[67] **13.** 17 sc, inc, 4 sc, inc, 25 sc, (inc, 4 sc)x2, inc, 8 sc [72] **14.** 51 sc, (inc, 5 sc)x2, inc, 8 sc[75] **15.** 17 sc, inc, 6 sc, inc, 26 sc, (inc, 6 sc)x2, inc, 9 sc [08] **16.** 54 sc, (inc, 7 sc)x2, inc, 9 sc [83] 17. 54 sc, (inc, 8 sc)x2, inc, 10 sc [86] 18. 12 sc. Take the first tusk, join the tusk to the head with 3 sc in both pieces (right sides together), 14 sc. Take the second tusk, join the tusk to the head with 3 sc in both pieces, 54 sc (7-9) [86] 19. 12 sc, s3 sc of the first tusk, sc, ch 6, skip 12 sts, sc, 3 sc of the second tusk, 54 sc (10-12) [80] **20.** sc in all 80 sts (13-15) [08] 21. (6 sc, dec)x4, 48 sc [76] **22.** (5 sc, dec)x4, 48 sc [72] 23-30. [8 rnds] sc in all 72 sts [72]

Place the eyes between round 15 and 16. The distance from one eye to the other is 18 stiches

Stuff the head and continue stuffing as you go

31. ch 4, skip 14 sts, 2 sc, ch 4, skip 14 sts, 3 sc, ch 4, skip 17 sts,

2 sc, ch 4, skip 17 sts, 3 sc (16-19)

32-33. [2 rnds] sc in all 26 sts

4 sc, slst. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

Front Legs

01.	Join the yarn. Sc in each unworked stitch of the front leg	[18]
02.	sc in all 18 sts	[18]
03.	(7 sc, dec)x2	[16]
04-06.	[3 rnds] sc in all 16 sts	[16]
07.	Sc-BLO in all 16 sts	[16]
08.	8 dec	[08]

Fasten off. Weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stich and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.



Back Legs

(in gray)


rnd.		sts.
01.	Join the yarn. Sc in each unworked stitch of the back leg	[21]
02.	Sc in all 21 sts	[21]
03.	(5 sc, dec)x3	[18]
04.	Sc in all 18 sts	[18]
05.	(7 sc, dec)x2	[16]
06.	Sc in all 16 sts	[16]
07.	Sc-BLO in all 16 sts	[16]
08.	8 dec	[08]

Fasten off. Weave the yarn tail through the front loop of each remaining stich and pull tight to close. Weave in the yarn end.



Sewing

Stuff the body and the legs. Using a tapestry needle, sew the belly. Weave in the yarn end.



Ears

(in gray)

Left ear

rnd.		sts.
01.	Ch 9. Start in the second chain from the hook:	
	7 sc, 3 sc in next st. On the other side of the	
	foundation chain: 6 sc, inc	[18]
02.	Inc, $6 \mathrm{sc}$, inc in next $3 \mathrm{sts}$, $6 \mathrm{sc}$, inc in next $2 \mathrm{sts}$	[24]
03.	8 sc, inc in next 6 sts, 10 sc	[30]
04.	9 sc, (inc, sc)x5, inc, 10 sc	[36]
05.	10 sc, (inc, 2 sc)x5, inc, 8 sc	
	2 sc, slst. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for	
	sewing	



Right ear

Follow the pattern of the left ear until round 4.

rnd.

05. 10 sc, (inc, 2 sc)x5, inc, 10 sc **[42]**2 sc, slst. Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing
