# Mini Bear Amigurumi Crochet Pattern





#### Yarn

Mini Bear with Scarf:

- · Super Bulky Chenille: Brown (20 grams), Cream (8 grams), Light Yellow (5 grams), Gold (5 grams).
  - · Sport: Brown (2 grams), Pink (2 grams).

Mini Bear with Leafs:

- · Super Bulky Chenille: Camel (20 grams), Cream (8 grams), Green (5 grams).
- · Sport: Brown (2 grams).

Mini Polar Bear:

- · Super Bulky Chenille: Cream (22 grams), Beige (5 grams).
- · Sport: Black (2 grams).

#### **Other Materials**

Main Crochet Hook: size 4.0mm. Other Crochet Hooks: size 6.0mm.

Fiberfill.

Black Safety Eyes 8mm. Scissors & yarn needle.

Stitch Marker.

### **Measures**

Height when made with the indicated yarn: 4.5 inches.

#### **About Chenille Yarn**

I always work this yarn with a 4.0mm crochet hook. If you crochet very tightly you may need to use a bigger hook, possibly 5.0mm.

Sometimes it is normal to make a mistake while working the pattern. If you need to remove a round you must do so carefully because this yarn tends to fray a lot and often gets stuck. Be patient.

Sewing parts with this type of yarn, can be a complicated process because this yarn frays easily. I recommend using a finer, resistant cotton yarn to sew the parts because it will be much easier to use. Try to find the most similar color.

When you have to work with this yarn and a sewing needle, you should try to look for one that has as large a hole as possible, so that the yarn deteriorates as little as possible.

You can work this pattern with any chenille yarn that meets the following requirements (100g / 3.5oz - 120m / 131yds). Below you can find the most used ones and with which you will obtain the best results:

- · Katia Bambi
- · Himalaya Dolphin Baby
- · Premier Parfait Chunky
- · Hobbii Honey Bunny

**Note:** This type of yarn is difficult to visualize on many occasions, so in some processes I will include photographs for your help taken using another yarn that is easier to see.

#### **Abbreviations**

Bobble dc x _	a bobble stitch made of x double crochet stitches.

# **General Tips**

All parts of this pattern are worked with the main crochet hook listed in the Materials section. If you have to use another size hook it will be indicated on the pattern.

Always use stitch marker to make it easier for you to count the stitches of your round and follow the pattern.

Stuff your project generously, but not too tightly. If you do, the design will lose its shape. For this process I recommend stuffing the pieces while you crochet them, so it will be easier for you.


Please note that safety eyes are not recommended for children under 3 years of age. In this case, you must make embroidered eyes.


All my patterns are worked in continuous rounds. When you must work in joined rounds you will have a note at the beginning of the part you are going to crochet.

# **Tutorials**

#### **Stitch Loops**

In these photos you can see the front loop (photo 1) and the back loop (photo 2) of a single crochet stitch.






## **Starting Ring**

The beginning of some pieces of this pattern will not use a regular Magic Ring. We will use another way to start.

Ch 2 (photo 1), sc 8 in 2nd ch from hook (photos 2 & 3).







#### **SC Increase**


Insert the hook under both loops of the indicated stitch, make a single crochet (photo 1), insert your hook under both loops of the same stitch and make a second single crochet (photo 2).





#### **Invisible SC Decrease**

Insert hook into the front loop of the first stitch of the decrease, insert the hook into the front loop of the next stitch of the decrease, yarn over and draw through both loop on hook, yarn over and draw through last two loops on hook (photo 2).






#### **Invisible Fasten Off**

Skip next stitch. Insert the needle into both loops of next stitch, pull yarn through (photo 1). Insert the needle through the back loop of the starting stitch (photo 2) and tighten it just enough so that the join looks like a regular stitch (photo 3).








## **Color Change**

Make the color change while doing the last step of the last stitch in the first color as follows: work the last stitch with the first color until you only have two loops on the hook (photo 1). Now with the new color, grab it around the hook and pull through the 2 remaining loops on your hook (photo 2). The next stitch you make will be the first stitch in the new color (photo 3).








#### Close using the front loops of the last stitches

Pull the yarn out of the last stitch. Now with your needle, pass the yarn through the front loops of the last stitches of the last round (from outside to inside). Pull the yarn tightly to close the piece (photos 1, 2 & 3).

Then hide the yarn inside the piece (photos 4 & 5).












#### Bobble dc 5

Yarn over, insert the hook into the indicated stitch (photo 1), yarn over and draw the yarn through the stitch. You now have three loops on the hook (photo 2). Yarn over the hook again and pull it through the first two loops on the hook. One half-closed double crochet is complete, and 2 loops remain on the hook (photo 3). In the same stitch, repeat the preceding steps four times. You should have 6 loops on your hook (photo 4). Yarn over your hook and draw the yarn through all 6 loops on the hook. One Bobble dc 5 stitch is complete (photo 5).


It is possible that in the pattern you have to do this same process but making a different number of dc stitches.



#### Bobble dc 5 with a new color

To do this process you must make the color change as explained previously in the stitch before starting the bobble stitch (*photo 1*). Then do the booble stitch as explained in the previous tutorial (*photo 2*). Finally you must take the old color to make the last yarn over and draw it through all loops on your hook (*photo 3*).

Then continue following the instructions of the pattern with the old color (photo 4).



# Mini Bear with Scarf

# **Head and Body**

With brown yarn ch 2, sc 8 in 2nd ch from hook.

01.	[inc] 8x	(16 sts)
02.	[sc, inc] 8x	(24 sts)
03.	[sc, inc, sc 2] 6x	(30 sts)
04 - 10.	(7 rnds) sc 30	(30 sts)

Put the black safety eyes between rnds 8 and 9. The first eye will be placed between stitches 1 and 2. The second eye will be placed between stitches 6 and 7 (photo 1).

11.	[sc, dec, sc 2] 6x	(24 sts)
12.	[sc 1, dec] 8x	(16 sts)
13.	FLO [sc 1, inc] 6x	(24 sts)
14 - 16.	(3 rnds) sc 24	(24 sts)
17.	brown color, sc 2, cream color, bobble dc 5,	
	brown color, sc 2, cream color, bobble dc 5,	
	brown color, sc 3, cream color, bobble dc 5,	
	brown color, sc 12, cream color, bobble dc 5,	
	brown color, sc 1 (photo 2)	(24 sts)

18.	FLO [sc, dec] 8x	(16 sts)
19.	[dec] 8x	(8 sts)

Stuff the head and body.

Close using the front loops of the last stitches. Fasten off.

# **Right Ear**

To make the ears you will work between rnds 4 and 7 of the head on both sides, right and left. You can add pins to help you (photos 3 & 4).

Attach a new brown yarn at 10th st between rnds 6 and 7.


**01.** 
$$\{\operatorname{ch} 1 + \operatorname{hdc} 1\}$$
 to the same st (photo 5) (2 sts)

Jump to 10th st between rnds 5 and 6.

**02.** 
$$\{dc 3\}$$
 to the same st (photo 6) (3 sts)

 $\label{eq:Jump to 10th st between rnds 4 and 5.}$ 

**03.** 
$$\{hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1\}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)













At this moment your ear has two tails (the tail from finishing the ear and the one left when attaching the yarn to start making it). Using your needle, pull these tails out through a stitch of your choice on the back of the head (photos 7 & 8).

Tie a knot with these tails and hide them inside the head (photos 9 & 10).









#### **Left Ear**

Now place the pins for your reference on the left side. You will work on 28th st *(photo 11)*. Attach a new brown yarn at 28th st between rnds 3 and 4.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 \}$$
 to the same st (2 sts)

Jump to 28th st between rnds 4 and 5.

$$\mathbf{02.} \qquad \{dc 3\} \text{ to the same st} \qquad (3 sts)$$

Jump to 28th st between rnds 5 and 6.

**03.** 
$$\{ hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1 \}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)

Repeat the process to secure the tails of this ear as you did with the first (photo 12).

#### Snout

With cream yarn ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. Invisible fastten off.


Sew or glue the snout between rows 8 and 10 of the head. Place it centered between the eyes.

With brown sport yarn and your needle add several horizontal stitches to make the nose. Then make a long downward stitch centered (1 stitch long).

#### Cheeks

With pink sport yarn and your needle add a stitch to make a small cheek under each eye. Place them between rnds 9 and 10 one st outward from each eye (photo 13).







#### Scarf

Use 6.0mm crochet hook. Take a light yellow yarn and a gold yarn. Make a loop to start.


Pass the hook under the light yellow yarn, yarn over with the light yellow color, and draw the yarn through the loop (photos 14, 15, 16 & 17).

Now pass the hook under the gold yarn, yarn over with the gold color, and draw the yarn through the loop (photos 18 & 19).

Continue alternating these two steps with the threads of the two colors until you obtain the desired length. My design has 60 repetitions.

Tie a knot at both ends with the tails of both colors (photo 20).

Finally, very carefully, you can burn the ends a little so that they do not fray (photos 21 & 22).



Place the scarf around the mini teddy bear's neck and tie a knot on one side.



# Mini Bear with Leafs

# **Head and Body**

With camel yarn ch 2, sc 8 in 2nd ch from hook.

01.	[inc] 8x	(16 sts)
02.	[sc, inc] 8x	(24 sts)
03.	[sc, inc, sc 2] 6x	(30 sts)
04 - 10.	(7 rnds) sc 30	(30 sts)

Put the black safety eyes between rnds 8 and 9. The first eye will be placed between stitches 2 and 3. The second eye will be placed between stitches 7 and 8.

Stuff the head and body.

Close using the front loops of the last stitches. Fasten off.

# **Right Ear**

To make the ears you will work between rnds 4 and 7 of the head on both sides, right and left. You can add pins to help you.

Attach a new camel yarn at 11th st between rnds 6 and 7.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 \}$$
 to the same st (2 sts)

Jump to 11th st between rnds 5 and 6.

Jump to 11th st between rnds 4 and 5.

**03.** 
$$\{ hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1 \}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)

At this moment your ear has two tails (the tail from finishing the ear and the one left when attaching the yarn to start making it). Using your needle, pull these tails out through a stitch of your choice on the back of the head.

Tie a knot with these tails and hide them inside the head.

#### **Left Ear**

Now place the pins for your reference on the left side. You will work on 29th st. Attach a new Camel yarn at 29th st between rnds 3 and 4.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 \}$$
 to the same st (2 sts)

Jump to 29th st between rnds 4 and 5.

$$\mathbf{02.} \qquad \{dc\ 3\}\ to\ the\ same\ st \qquad \qquad (3\ sts)$$

Jump to 29th st between rnds 5 and 6.

**03.** 
$$\{ hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1 \}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)

Repeat the process to secure the tails of this ear as you did with the first.

#### Snout

With cream yarn ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. Invisible fastten off.

Sew or glue the snout between rows 8 and 10 of the head. Place it centered between the eyes.

With brown sport yarn and your needle add several horizontal stitches to make the nose. Then make a long downward stitch centered (1 stitch long).

#### Cheeks

Make the cheeks under the eyes with a little blush and a soft brush.


#### Leafs

Attach a new green yarn at 3rd st between starting ring and rnd 1 (photos 23 & 24).





Look at these photos for your help to make the tip of the leaf.



To make the second leaf attach a new green yarn between the center of the starting ring and sts 7 and 8 between the starting ring and rnd 1.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 + ch \ 1 + slst \ 1 \}$$
 in previous  $dc + hdc \ 1 + ch \ 1 + slst \ 1 \}$  in the same st  $(photo \ 29)$  (8 sts)

Repeat the process to secure the tails of the leaves as you did with the ears.





# **Mini Polar Bear**

# **Head and Body**

With cream yarn ch 2, sc 8 in 2nd ch from hook.

inc] 8x	(24 sts)
inc, sc 2] 6x	(30 sts)

Put the black safety eyes between rnds 8 and 9. The first eye will be placed between stitches 2 and 3. The second eye will be placed between stitches 7 and 8.

Stuff the head and body.

Close using the front loops of the last stitches. Fasten off.

# **Right Ear**

To make the ears you will work between rnds 4 and 7 of the head on both sides, right and left. You can add pins to help you.

Attach a new cream yarn at 11th st between rnds 6 and 7.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 \}$$
 to the same st (2 sts)

Jump to 11th st between rnds 5 and 6.

Jump to 11th st between rnds 4 and 5.

**03.** 
$$\{ hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1 \}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)

At this moment your ear has two tails (the tail from finishing the ear and the one left when attaching the yarn to start making it). Using your needle, pull these tails out through a stitch of your choice on the back of the head.

Tie a knot with these tails and hide them inside the head.

#### **Left Ear**

Now place the pins for your reference on the left side. You will work on 29th st.

Attach a new cream yarn at 29th st between rnds 3 and 4.

**01.** 
$$\{ ch \ 1 + hdc \ 1 \}$$
 to the same st (2 sts)

Jump to 29th st between rnds 4 and 5.

Jump to 29th st between rnds 5 and 6.

**03.** 
$$\{ hdc 1 + ch 1 + slst 1 \}$$
 to the same st (3 sts)

Repeat the process to secure the tails of this ear as you did with the first.

#### Snout

With cream yarn ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. Invisible fastten off.

Sew or glue the snout between rows 8 and 10 of the head. Place it centered between the eyes.

With black sport yarn and your needle add several horizontal stitches to make the nose. Then make a long downward stitch centered (1 stitch long).

#### Cheeks

Make the cheeks under the eyes with a little blush and a soft brush.
