





Crochet Pattern

Start Here...

- · Please, read the whole pattern through properly so you have a good overview.
- · This amigurumi is made up of the following parts:
 - · 1 Head with 1 Beak, 1 Headband and 3 Flowers, 2 Wings, 1 Body, 2 Legs with 2 Feet, 1 Dress.
 - · 1 Duckling Plush with 1 Head and Body, 1 Beak and 2 Wings.
- · Measurements:
 - Sleeping Duck: 9 inches (23 cm)
 Duckling Plush: 3.1 inches (8 cm)

Materials

- · 4 mm crochet hook.
- · Fiberfill.
- · Scissors & needle.
- · Stitchmarker.
- · Worsted Weight yarn (Katia Merino Aran): 3 Off White (90 grams), 80 Yellow (just a little), 77 Mustard (20 grams), 91 Reseda Green (50 grams), 83 Medium Rose (15 grams), 84 Dark Rose (just a little).
- · Thread: Just a little of Black.

Notes

- · Note that the orientation of all parts of the pattern are set looking at the project from the front.
- · If you want to make my Small Version you should use Sport yarn and a 2.75mm crochet hook.






Techniques

Third Loop

In this pattern you have to work with the Third Loop. To find this loop, look behind the back loop on the back side of the stitch and you'll see a loop a little bit below. This is the Third Loop. In the images below you will see the Third Loop on a project worked only with single crochet stitches.





Glossary:

sc: single crochet || ch: chain || sl st: slip stitch || dc: double crochet || hdc: half double crochet || trc: triple crochet inc: increase || dec: invisible decrease || BLO: back loop only || FLO: front loop only



Crochet Pattern

Generic Processes

Invisible Join

- · Skip next stitch. Insert the needle into both loops of next stitch, pull yarn through. Insert the needle through the back loop of the starting stitch and tighten it just enough so that the join looks like a regular stitch.
- · Depending on the part you are working on you should leave a long tail to sew later or weave in the end.









Color Change

- · I make the color change at the final part of the last stitch that you must work with old color.
- · Work the last stitch of the old color as usual, until you only have 2 loops on the hook. Take the yarn of the new color, grab it around the hook and pull through the 2 remaining loops on your hook. The next stitch you make will be the first of the new color.







Sew Edges

It's an easy process. Just take your piece, flatten it, and sew the open edges closed. Depending on the pattern, you should fasten off or leave a long tail to sew it later.







Crochet Pattern

Head:

- · You must stuff this part little by little as you crochet it, making the process easier.
- · This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Off White varn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: sc inc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (24 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 6 times (30 sts).

5 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (36 sts).

6 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 6 times (42 sts).

7 round: * 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (48 sts).

8 round: 1 sc in each sc (48 sts).

9 round: *1 sc in next 3 sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 4 sc * repeat 6 times (54 sts).

10 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (54 sts, 9 rounds in total).

19 round: *1 sc in next 3 sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 4 sc * repeat 6 times (48 sts).

20 round: * 1 sc in next 6 sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (42 sts).

· To make the eyes follow the chart below. Use black thread and your needle.







Round 16

 \cdot Now you must do and sew the beak and hairs (long and short). To learn how to make them, please see the explanations below.

21 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 6 times (36 sts).

22 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (30 sts).

23 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 6 times (24 sts).

24 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (18 sts). Fasten off.

· Make the small cheeks with rouge.

Beak:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Yellow yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (9 sts).

2 round: 1 sc in each sc (9 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (12 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

5 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts).

6 round: 1 sc in next 8 sc, 3 sc in next sc, 1 sc in next 9 sc (20 sts). Close with invisible join and leave a long

tail for sewing that piece later.

· Stuff the beak. Then sew it on the head. Place it centered, with the increases of round 6 facing up, between rounds 15 and 22. Fasten off.



Crochet Pattern

Long Hair:

· With Off White yarn do 11 ch. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

Short Hair:

- · With Off White yarn do 7 ch. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.
- · Sew the two hairs (long and short) together on top of the head. Place them centered.

Headband:

- · With Medium Rose yarn do 50 ch. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.
- · Place the headband around the duck's head, just in front of the hairs. Add a few stitches to secure it. Fasten off.

Flower: (x3)

- · Make 2 flowers in Medium Rose yarn and 1 flower in Dark Rose yarn. Create a Magic Ring with * 2 ch + 1 hdc + 2 ch + 1 sl st * repeat 4 times. Close the Magic Ring and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.
- · Place the three flowers on the headband, on the right side and sew them. Fasten off.







Crochet Pattern

Wing: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Off White yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

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1 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (9 sts).
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2 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (12 sts).

3 round: *1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 3 times (15 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (18 sts).

5 round: *1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 3 times (21 sts).

6 to 13 round: 1 sc in each sc (21 sts, 8 rounds in total).

14 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 3 times (18 sts).

15 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts).

16 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times (15 sts).

17 round: 1 sc in each sc (15 sts).

18 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 3 times (12 sts).

19 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts).

20 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times (9 sts). Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for

sewing that piece later.

· The wings don't need to be stuffed. Sew the edges of each wing following the instructions on page 2, in section "Generic Processes: Sew Edges".

Body:

- · You must stuff these parts little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.
- · This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Off White yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: sc inc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (24 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 6 times (30 sts).

5 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (36 sts).

6 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts).

7 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 6 times (42 sts).

8 to 11 round: 1 sc in each sc (42 sts, 4 rounds in total).

12 round: 1 sc in next 16 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next 17 sc (39 sts).

13 to 15 round: 1 sc in each sc (39 sts, 3 rounds in total).

16 round: 1 sc in next 15 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next 15 sc (36 sts).

17 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (36 sts, 2 rounds in total).

19 round: 1 sc in next 14 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next 13 sc (33 sts).

20 to 21 round: 1 sc in each sc (33 sts, 2 rounds in total).

22 round: 1 sc in next 13 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next 11 sc (30 sts).

23 to 24 round: 1 sc in each sc (30 sts, 2 rounds in total).

25 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 6 times (24 sts).

26 to 28 round: 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 3 rounds in total).

29 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

30 to 32 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts, 3 rounds in total). Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that

piece later.



Crochet Pattern

Tail:

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Off White yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: 1 sc in each sc (6 sts).

2 round: 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next sc (9 sts).

3 round: 1 sc in next 2 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next sc (12 sts).
4 round: 1 sc in each sc (12 sts). Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.

· Stuff the tail.

Leg: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Mustard do 6 ch. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring. Leave a long tail at the beginning.

1 round: Work with Third Loop only this round. 1 sc in each sc (6 sts).

2 to 5 round: 1 sc in each sc (6 sts, 4 rounds in total). Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that

piece later.

Foot: (x2)

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Mustard yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (9 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (12 sts).

3 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 2 sc * repeat 3 times (15 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times (18 sts).

5 round: *1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 3 times (21 sts).

6 to 7 round: 1 sc in each sc (21 sts, 2 rounds in total).

8 round: *1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec, 1 sc in next 3 sc * repeat 3 times (18 sts). Fasten off.

- · Flatten the feet. I have placed the start of the round in the middle of the foot, at the bottom.
- · Attach a new Mustard yarn at one end and working with the two stitches on both sides (top and bottom) do:

9 round: 1 ch, 1 sc + 2 hdc + 1 sc in the same st, * 1 sc in next 3 sc, 1 sc + 2 hdc + 1 sc in next sc * repeat 2 times. Fasten off.









Crochet Pattern

Finishing the Foot:

- · Place the leg on the wrong side of the foot, between rounds 2 and 3. You can use pins to help you. Sew it on. Fasten off.
- · Repeat the same process with the other foot.





Dress:

· With Reseda Green yarn do 18 ch. Join with sl st in first ch to form a ring.

1 round: 1 ch + 1 sc in the same ch, 1 sc in next ch, sc inc in next ch, * 1 sc in next 2 ch, sc inc in next ch * repeat 5 times (24 sts).

· This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker.

2 round: * 1 sc in next 3 ch. sc inc in next ch * repeat 6 times (30 sts).

3 round: 1 sc in next 5 sc, skip next 5 sc, 5 ch, 1 sc in next 10 sc, skip next 5 sc, 5 ch, 1 sc in next 5 sc (30

sts, ch included).

4 round: 1 sc in each st (30 sts).5 round: 3 dc in each sc (90 sts).

6 to 10 round: 1 dc in each dc (90 sts, 5 rounds in total).

11 round: Change to Medium Rose yarn. * 1 sl st in next dc, 2 ch * repeat 90 times (270 sts, st sl and ch

included). Fasten off.

Sleeve: (x2)

· Attach a new Medium Rose yarn on one of the sleeves. Remember that you must work sc and ch.

1 round: * 1 sl st in next st, 2 ch * repeat 10 times (30 sts, sl st and ch included). Fasten off.

· Repeat the same process with the other sleeve.

Finishing the Sleeping Duck:

- · Keep in mind that the body has a special shape and is not completely symmetrical. When sewing the parts on the body you should keep in mind that the decreases of rounds 12 to 22 should be facing up.
- · Sew the wings on both sides of the body, right and left, on round 27.
- · Then sew the tail on the body. Place it centered, between rounds 9 and 13.
- · Sew the legs on both sides of the body, at the same level as the wings, between rounds 6 and 7.
- · Put the dress on (from the top, inserting the wings through the sleeves).
- · Finally sew the head to the body. I have placed mine turned to the left side.



Crochet Pattern

Duckling Plush

Head and Body:

- · You must stuff these parts little by little as you crochet them, making the process easier.
- · This part is worked continuously. You should use a stitch marker. With Off White yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 sc.

1 round: sc inc in each sc (12 sts).

2 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

3 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts).

4 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 6 times (24 sts).

5 to 8 round: 1 sc in each sc (24 sts, 4 rounds in total).

9 round: * 1 sc in next 2 sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (18 sts).

10 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (12 sts).

11 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 4 times (8 sts).

12 round: 1 sc in each sc (8 sts).

13 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 4 times (12 sts).

14 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, sc inc in next 3 sc, 1 sc in next 5 sc (15 sts).

15 round: 1 sc in each sc (15 sts).

16 round: 1 sc in next 4 sc, * 1 sc in next sc, sc inc in next sc * repeat 3 times, 1 sc in next 5 sc (18 sts).

17 to 18 round: 1 sc in each sc (18 sts, 2 rounds in total).

19 round: * 1 sc in next sc, sc dec * repeat 6 times (12 sts).

20 round: * sc dec * repeat 6 times (6 sts).

- · Using your yarn needle, weave the yarn tail through each remaining stitch and pull it tight to close. Fasten off.
- · To make the eyes, you must follow the "Eyes Chart" on page 4 of the sleeping duck, but you must make them smaller. The eyes are placed between rounds 5 and 7. For your reference they have a distance

between them of 2 sts.

· Make the small cheeks with rouge.

Beak:

- · With Yellow yarn create a Magic Ring with 6 hdc. Join with sl st and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.
- · With the help of your crochet hook push the center of the Magic Ring outwards.
- · Then sew it on the head. Place it centered, between rounds 6 and 8. Fasten off.

Wing: (x2)

- · With Off White yarn do 4 ch.
 - **1 round:** 1 sl st in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in next ch, 4 hdc in next ch, working now in the opposite side of the foundation ch, 1 sc in next ch, 1 sl st in next ch (8 sts, *sl st included*). Close with invisible join and leave a long tail for sewing that piece later.
- · Sew the wings on both sides of the body, right and left, between rounds 14 and 15.


Little Bow:

· Pass a new Medium Rose yarn around the duckling's neck and make a little bow with the ends. I have placed it on the right side.







