Materials and Tools

2/10

YarnArt JEANS, 55% cotton, 45% acrylic;
160m/50gr

- color #82 olive green for the leaf and stem

Alize Cotton Gold, 55% cotton, 45% acrylic; 330
m/50gr

- color #83 pumpkin for the half of the orange
- color #55 white or #62 milk white for the segments

Alize Cotton Baby Soft, 50% cotton, 50% acrylic;
170 m/100gr

- color #37 orange for the orange peel
- crochet hook that is convenient for you when using this kind of yarn (I used 2.5 mm hook)
- needles for sewing
- wooden ring 2.2-2.4" (5.5-6 cm) in diameter
- scissors
- safety pins
- stuffing (holofiber or any synthetic material)
- a rattle

Legend

CH = chain

MC = magic circle

SC = single crochet

INC = increase (crochet 2 st in one stitch)

DEC = decrease (crochet 2 st together)

(...) = the figure inside the parenthesis equals the number of stitches in the round

X = repeat the instruction X times

Half of the orange

4/10

Start with white or milk white yarn:

Rnd 1: 8 SC in MC (8)

Continue with yarn Alize Cotton Gold No83 pumpkin orange:

Rnd 2: 8 INC (16)

Rnd 3: (INC, 1 SC) x 8 times (24)

Rnd 4: (2 SC, INC) x 8 times (32)

Rnd 5: (3 SC, INC) x 8 times (40)

Rnd 6: 2 SC, (INC, 4 SC) x 7 times, INC, 2 SC (48)

Rnd 7: 1 SC, (INC, 5 SC) x 7 times, INC, 4 SC (56)

Rnd 8: (INC, 6 SC) x 8 times (64)

Change the thread to white or milk white:

Rnd 9: 64 SC (64)

Change the thread to yarn Alize Cotton Baby No37 orange

Rnd 10: 64 SC (64)

Cut the thread and hide yarn tail inside the half of the orange.

Peel of the orange half

Crochet with Alize Cotton Baby #37 yarn:

Rnd 1: 6 SC in MC (6)

Rnd 2: 6 INCR (12)

Rnd 3: (INCR, 1 SC) x 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (INCR, 2 SC) x 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (INCR, 3 SC) x 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (INCR, 4 SC) x 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (INCR, 5 SC) x 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (INCR, 6 SC) x 6 times (48)

Rnd 9: (INCR, 7 SC) x 6 times (54)

Rnd 10: (INCR, 8 SC) x 6 times (60)

Rnd 11: [(INC, 9 SC) x 2 times, 10 SC] x 2 times (64)

Rnds 12-17 (6 rounds): 64 SC (64)

Cut the thread, hide yarn tail inside the peel of the orange half.



Round orange

Crochet with Alize Cotton Baby #37 yarn:

Rnd 1: 6 SC in MC (6)

Rnd 2: 6 INCR (12)

Rnd 3: (INCR, 1 SC) x 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: (INCR, 2 SC) x 6 times (24)

Rnd 5: (INCR, 3 SC) x 6 times (30)

Rnd 6: (INCR, 4 SC) x 6 times (36)

Rnd 7: (INCR, 5 SC) x 6 times (42)

Rnd 8: (INCR, 6 SC) x 6 times (48)

Rnds 9-18 (10 rounds): 48 SC (48)

Rnd 19: (DEC, 6 SC) x 6 times (42)

Rnd 20: (DEC, 5 SC) x 6 times (36)

Stuff your orange at this point, and put the rattle inside. I recommend to stuff the head as tight as possible.

Rnd 21: (DEC, 4 SC) x 6 times (30)

Rnd 22: (DEC, 3 SC) x 6 times (24)

Rnd 23: (DEC, 2 SC) x 6 times (18)

Rnd 24: (DEC, 1 SC) x 6 times (12)

Rnd 25: 6 DEC (6)

Cut the thread, fasten hole, hide yarn tail inside the orange.

Leaf and stem

Rnd 1: 6 SC in MC (6)

Rnd 2: (2 SC, INC) X 2 times (8)

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) X 2 times (10)

Rnd 4: (4 SC, INC) X 2 times (12)

Rnd 5: (5 SC, INC) X 2 times (14)

Rnd 6: (6 SC, INC) X 2 times (16)

Rnd 7: (7 SC, INC) X 2 times (18)

Rnd 8-10 (3 rounds): 18 SC (18)

Rnd 11: (7 SC, DEC) X 2 times (16)

Rnd 12: (6 SC, DEC) X 2 times (14)

Rnd 13: (5 SC, DEC) X 2 times (12)

Rnd 14: (SC, DEC) X 4 times (8)

The number of rounds for the stem is approximate, please take into account the thickness of your ring and density of your crochet fabric; from time to time fix the stem with the leaf on the ring as shown in the Assembly section.

Assembling

9/10

Rnd 1: 6 SC in MC (6)

Rnd 2: (2 SC, INC) x 2 times (8)

Rnd 3: (3 SC, INC) x 2 times (10)

Rnd 4: (4 SC, INC) x 2 times (12)

Rnd 5: (5 SC, INC) x 2 times (14)

Rnd 6: (6 SC, INC) x 2 times (16)

Rnd 7: (7 SC, INC) x 2 times (18)

Rnd 8-10 (3 rounds): 18 SC (18)

Rnd 11: (7 SC, DEC) x 2 times (16)

Rnd 12: (6 SC, DEC) x 2 times (14)

Rnd 13: (5 SC, DEC) x 2 times (12)

Rnd 14: (SC, DEC) x 4 times (8)

Sew on the stem. Fix the orange with the stem on the ring as shown on the photo.

Orange baby rattle is ready!
