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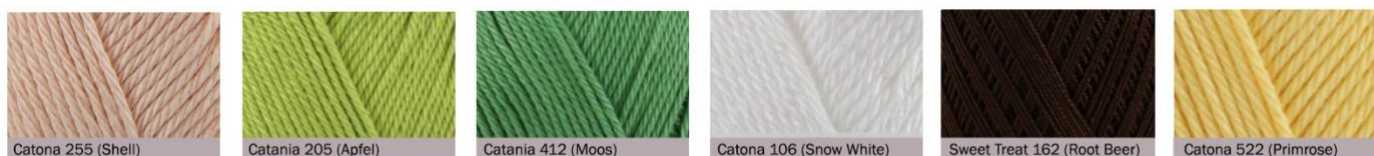
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Supplies

I used Scheepjes Catona (4ply/Sport) 50g ball = 125 metres

Schachenmayr Catania (4ply/Sport) 50g ball = 125 metres

Scheepjes Sweet Treat (2ply) 25g ball = 140 metres, in the following colours:



If you can't get hold of the same yarn I used then this website [Yarn Substitution](#) is a good online resource for finding alternatives.

Crochet Hooks: 2mm (I use Clover hooks)

9mm safety eyes, I purchased mine here: [Eyes](#)

2mm wire, purchased mine here: [BENECREAT 12 Gauge \(2mm\)](#)

Needle for weaving in ends/Long sharp needle for attaching the head

Fabric Glue or Hot Glue to attach the wig base (optional, you can sew it)

Stitch markers

Stuffing

Blusher/blusher brush, I purchased mine here: [Blusher](#)

Gauge

Using the materials suggested my doll was approx. 26 cm tall

You can change the size of the doll by using a smaller/bigger hook and thinner/thicker yarn.

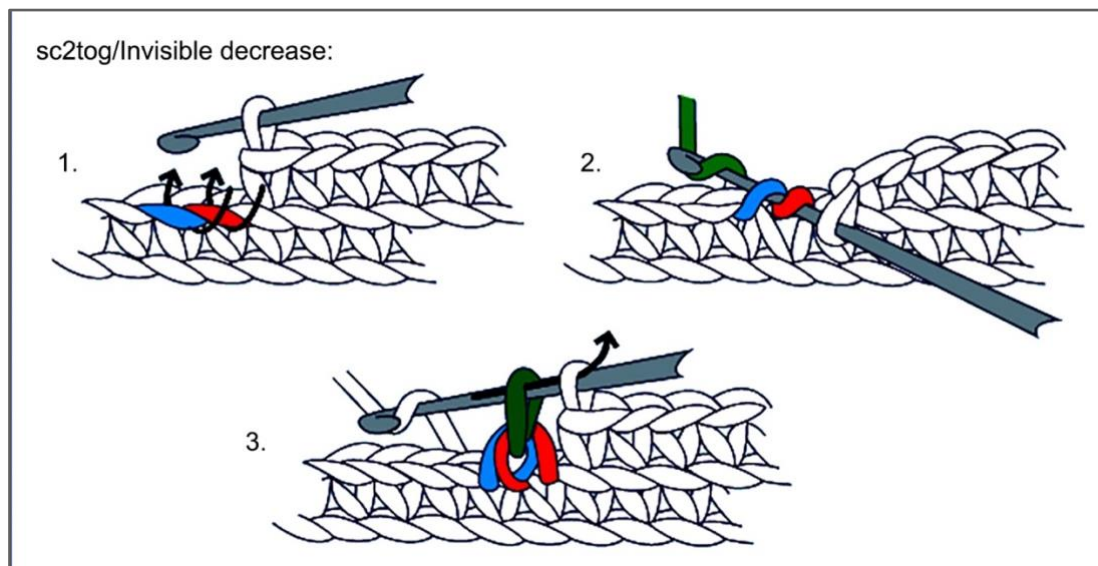


Notes

The doll is worked in continuous rounds, do not join at the end of each round unless specifically asked to in the pattern.

Use a stitch marker/scrap of contrast yarn to keep track of where you are. I mark the last stitch of each round.

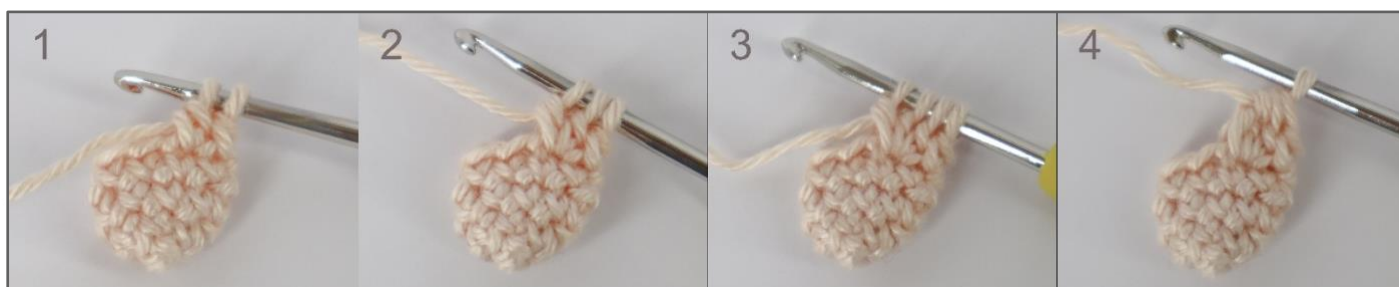
Sc2tog/Invisible decrease:



Invisible increases: Work the first of the two stitches by inserting the hook into the back loop only, work the second of the two stitches into both loops.

3dcc1

1. Yarn over (yo), insert your hook into the indicated stitch, yo, pull up a loop, yo, pull through 2 loops. You'll have 2 loops left on your hook and one half-worked double crochet.
2. Yo, insert hook into same stitch, repeat Step 1. You'll have 3 loops on your hook and two half-worked double crochets.
3. Repeat Step 2. You'll have 4 loops on your hook and three half-worked double crochets
4. Yo, pull through all 4 loops on hook.



X-shaped single crochet



To make the x shaped single crochet:

Insert hook into stitch, yarn **under**, pull up a loop, yarn **over**, pull through 2 loops

This method creates a tighter cleaner looking stitch.

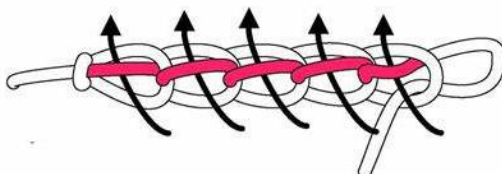
Standard single crochet

To make the standard single crochet:

Insert hook into stitch, yarn **over**, pull up a loop, yarn **over**, pull through 2 loops

Back Bumps

How a crocheted chain looks from the back:



Insert crochet hook into the "bumps" as indicated by the arrows.

Wire for Arms

Cut a piece of wire for the arms, approx. 32cm

Fold the wire in half and then fold each end over approx. 1cm (see photo)



Skirt

Hook 2mm

Leaves

Make 6 in colour - Catania 205 Apfel and 6 in colour – Catania 412 Moos

Row 1 Ch11 tr in 4th ch from hook, tr in next st, tr[^] in next 2 sts, tr in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc+ch1+sc in last loop, (now work other side of ch) hdc in next st, dc in next st, tr in next st, tr[^] in next 2 sts, tr in next st, tr[^] in next st, ch1 work 6 sc along top of leaf.



You will now crochet the leaves together to form the skirt. The leaves will overlap with the dark green colour at the back, see photos:



Row 1 crochet leaves together, join, (36)

Rnd 2 ch1, sc in same st, sc in each st around, join, (36)

Fasten off, put to one side to crochet to the body later.



Arms (make 2)

Hook 2mm, skin colour 255 (Shell)

Use the "X" shaped single crochet

You don't need to stuff the arms

Rnd 1 create a magic ring, make 6 sc in ring, (6)

Rnd 2 *sc in next st, sc^ in next st* 3 times, (9)

Rnd 3 sc in each st around, (9)

Rnd 4 *sc in next 2 sts, sc^ in next st* 3 times, (12)

Rnd 5 3dccl in next st, sc in next 11 sts, (12)

Rnd 6 *sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts* 3 times, (9)

Rnd 7 sc in next st, *sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts* 2 times, (7)

Rnd 8 sc in each st around, (7)

Rnd 9 sc^ in next st, sc in next 3 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 2 sts, (9)

Rnd 10 sc in next 4 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 4 sts, (10)

Rnd 11-13 sc in each st around, (10)

Rnd 14 sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts, (9)

Rnd 15 sc in each st around, (9)

Rnd 16 sc2tog, sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, (7)

Rnd 17 sc in next 4 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 2 sts, (8)

Rnd 18 sc in next 1 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 6 sts, (9)

Rnd 19 sc in next 4 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 4 sts, (10)

Rnd 20 sc in next 1 sts, sc^ in next st, sc in next 8 sts, (11)

Rnd 21-23 sc in each st around, (11)

Left Arm

Rnd 24 sc in next 8 sts, (11)

Right Arm



Rnd 24 sc in next 3 sts, (11)

Fasten off. Put to one side to connect to the body later.

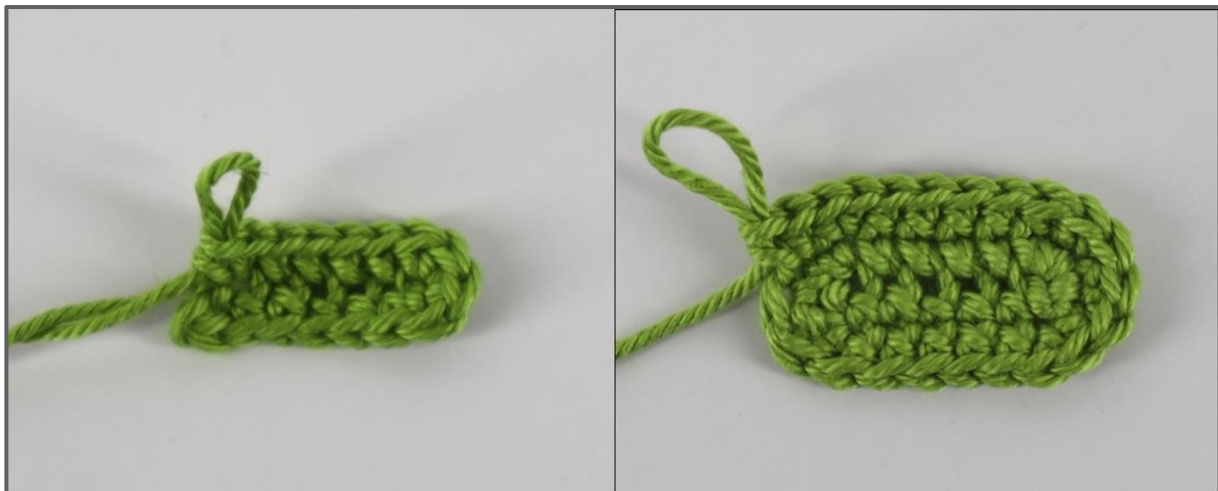


Legs (make 2)

Hook 2mm, start with colour Catania 205 (Apfel)

Use the "X" shaped single crochet

Rnd 1 ch8 sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 5 sts, make 3 sc in last loop, (now crochet on the other side of the ch) sc in next 5 sts, sc[^] in next st, (16)



Rnd 2 sc[^] in next st, sc in next 5 sts, sc[^] in next 3 sts, sc in next 5 sts, sc[^] in next 2 sts, (22)

Rnd 3 sc in next st, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 6 sts, sc[^] in next 5 sts, sc in next 5 sts, *sc in next st, sc[^] in next st* 2 times, (30)

Cut soles to go inside, make 2



Rnd 4 (work in BLO) sc in each st around, (30)

Rnd 5-7 sc in each st around, (30)

Insert cardboard sole

Rnd 8 sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog 8 times, sc in next 6 sts, sl in next st, change to skin on last yarn over (22)

Rnd 9 (work in BLO) sl in each st around, (22)



Start stuffing the toes, keep stuffing firmly and often as you go



Rnd 10 (work in BLO) sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog 4 times, sc in next 7 sts, (18)

Pause here to make a 3dccl stitch at the front of the shoe:

Join white yarn to the centre loop, ch2, make a 3dccl (like you did for the thumb when making the arms) fasten off, use a needle to sew the tail ends inside the shoe and knot the ends together:



Rnd 11 sc in next 5sts, sc2tog 4 times, sc in next 5 sts, (14)

Rnd 12 sc in each st around, (14)

Rnd 13 sc[^] in next st, sc in next 13 sts, (15)

Rnd 14 sc in next 2 sts, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 11 sts, sc[^] in next st, (17)

Rnd 15 sc in next 17 sts, (17)

Rnd 16 sc in next 3 sts, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 11 sts, sc[^] in next st, sc in next st, (19)

Rnd 17-19 sc in each st around, (19)

Rnd 20 sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog, sc in next 11 sts, sc2tog, sc in next st, (17)

Rnd 21 sc in each st around, (17)

Rnd 22 sc in next st, sc2tog, sc in next 6 sts, sc[^] in next 3 sts, sc in next 5 sts, (19)

Rnd 23 sc in each st around, (19)

Rnd 24 sc[^] in next st, sc in next st, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog 3 times, sc in next 5 sts, (18)

Rnd 25 sc in each st around, (18)

Rnd 26 sc[^] in next st, sc in next 5 sts, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 5 sts, sc[^] in next st, sc in next 5 sts, (21)

Rnd 27-30 sc in each st around, (21)

Left Leg

Rnd 31 sc in each st around, (21) Fasten off

Right Leg

Rnd 31 sc in each st around, (21)

Rnd 32 sc in next 11 sts, change to white on last yarn over (21)

Do not fasten off continue to connecting the legs.



Connecting the legs/Body

Rnd 1 (RIGHT LEG) ch 3, (**LEFT LEG**) sc in next 21 sts, sc in next 3 ch sts, (**RIGHT LEG**) sc in next 21 sts, sc in next 2 ch sts, (place stitch marker here this marks the end of the row), (48)



Rnd 2 sc in next ch st, sc in next 47 sts, (48)

Rnd 3-6 sc in each st around, (48)

Rnd 9 sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog* 3 times, sc in next 5 sts, (44)

Rnd 8 sc in each st around, (44)

Rnd 9 *sc2tog, sc in next 9 sts* 4 times, (40)

Rnd 10 sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog* 3 times, sc in next 4 sts, (36)

Change to green at the end of row 10

On the next round you will crochet the skirt to the body working both 2 loops on the skirt and FLO on the body:



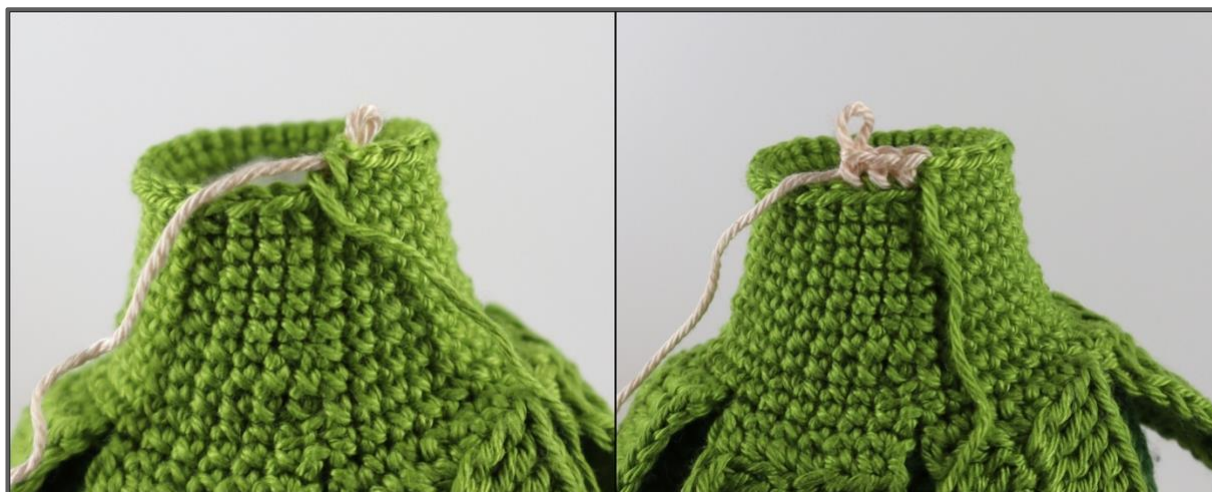
Rnd 11 (SKIRT+BODY) sc in each st around, (36)

Rnd 12-13 sc in each st around, (36)

Rnd 14 *sc2tog, sc in next 7 sts* 4 times, (32)

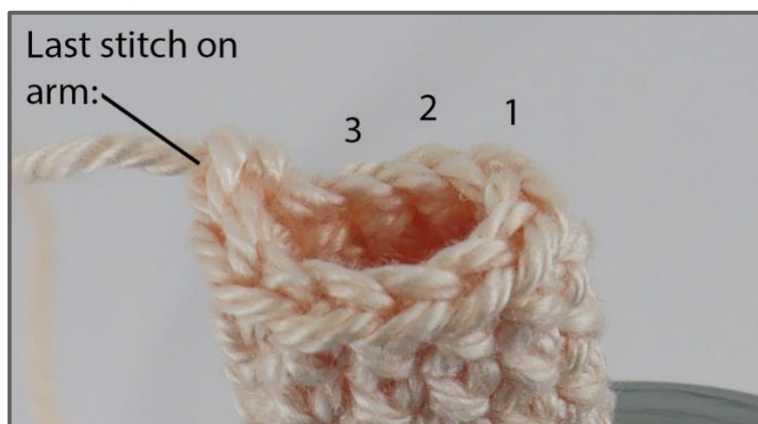
Rnd 15-19 sc in each st around, (32)

Change to skin at the end of row 19, do not cut the green yarn pull it to the front you will use it to finish the top of the dress later.



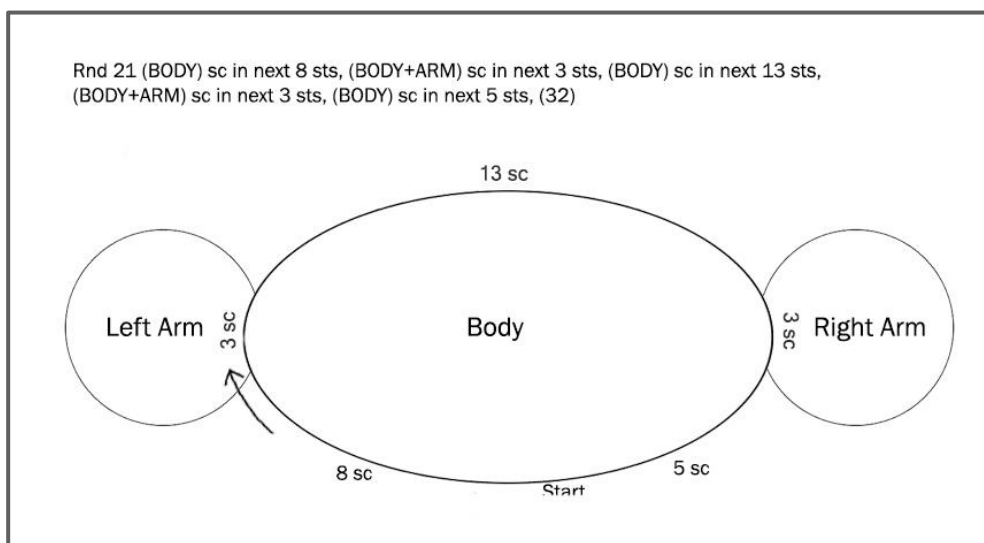
Rnd 20 (BLO) sc in each st around, (32)

On the next row you will connect the arms. Each arm is connected over 3 sts on Rnd 21, so you will work through the first stitch on the arm and the next stitch on the body (going through 4 loops) when you make your single crochet. See picture below to show the 3 sts on each arm you need to work through. You will work through the stitch marked 1 first. I like to work over the tail end.

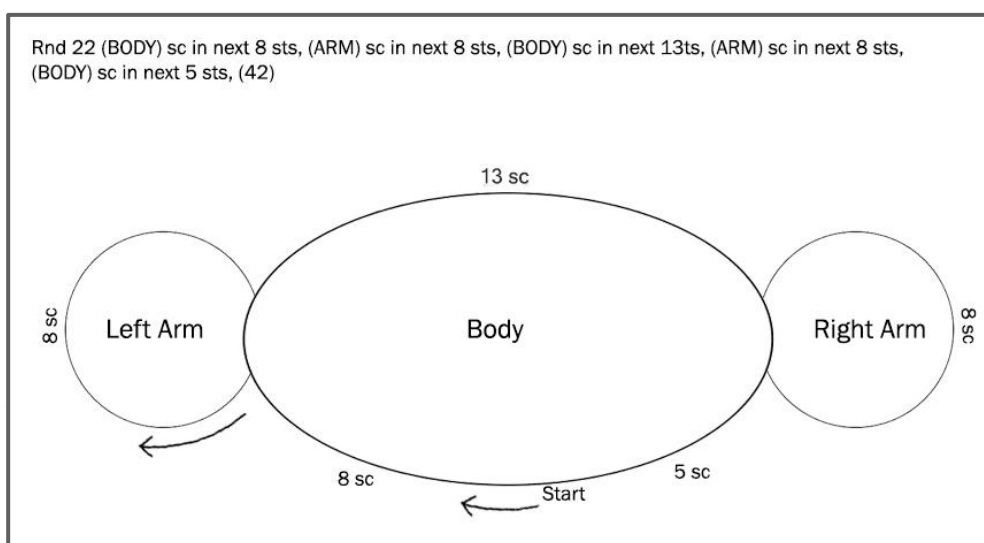


Rnd 21 (BODY) sc in next 8 sts, (BODY+ARM) sc in next 3 sts, (BODY) sc in next 13 sts, (BODY+ARM) sc in next 3 sts, (BODY) sc in next 5 sts, (32)





Rnd 22 (BODY) sc in next 8 sts, (ARM) sc in next 8 sts, (BODY) sc in next 13 sts, (ARM) sc in next 8 sts, (BODY) sc in next 5 sts, (42)





Pause here to finish the top of the dress. Insert hook into first loop at back of dress and pull up a loop,

Ch1, sc in same st, sc in next 11 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next st, dc[^] in next 2 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, dc[^] in next 2 sts, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in next 9 sts, join, (36) Fasten off, weave in ends.



Continue to row 23:

Rnd 23 sc in each st around (42)

Insert wire into the arms and twist in the middle:





Rnd 24 sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next st, sc2tog* 3 times, sc in next 10 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next st, sc2tog* 3 times, sc in next 3 sts (34)

Rnd 25 sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next st, sc2tog* 2 times, sc in next 9 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next st, sc2tog* 2 times, sc in next 3 sts (28)

Rnd 26 sc2tog, sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next st, sc2tog* 3 times, sc in next 2 sts, *sc2tog, sc in next st* 3 times, sc in next 2 sts, (20)

Rnd 27 *sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog* 5 times, (15)

Rnd 28-39 sc in each st around, (15) (when you get to row 37 trim any excess wire)

Rnd 40 *sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog* 3 times, (12)

Fasten off, use a needle to thread the tail end through the front loops of the remaining stitches and pull the hole closed. Weave in ends.



Head

Hook 2mm, colour 255 (Shell)

Use the "X" shaped single crochet

The head is worked from the bottom up beginning with the neck cavity

Rnd 1 create a magic ring, make 9 sc in ring, (9)

Rnd 2 sc^ in each st around, (18)

Rnd 3-12 sc in each st around, (18)

Rnd 13 sc^ in each st around, (36)

Rnd 14 *sc in next 5 sts, sc^ in next st* 6 times, (42)

Rnd 15 sc in next 3 sts, sc^ in next st *sc in next 6 sts, sc^ in next st* 5 times, sc in next 3 sts, (48)

Rnd 16 *sc in next 7 sts, sc^ in next st* 6 times, (54)

At this stage you can push the neck cavity up into the head, then continue to Row 17



Rnd 17-22 sc in each st around (54)

Rnd 23 sc in next 13 sts, dc in next st, sc in next 8 sts, ch1, sk next st, sc in next 9 sts, ch1, sk next st, sc in next 7 sts, dc in next st, sc in next 13 sts, (54)

Rnd 24 sc in next 22 sts, sc in ch1 space, sc in next 9 sts, sc in ch1 space, sc in next 21 sts, (54)

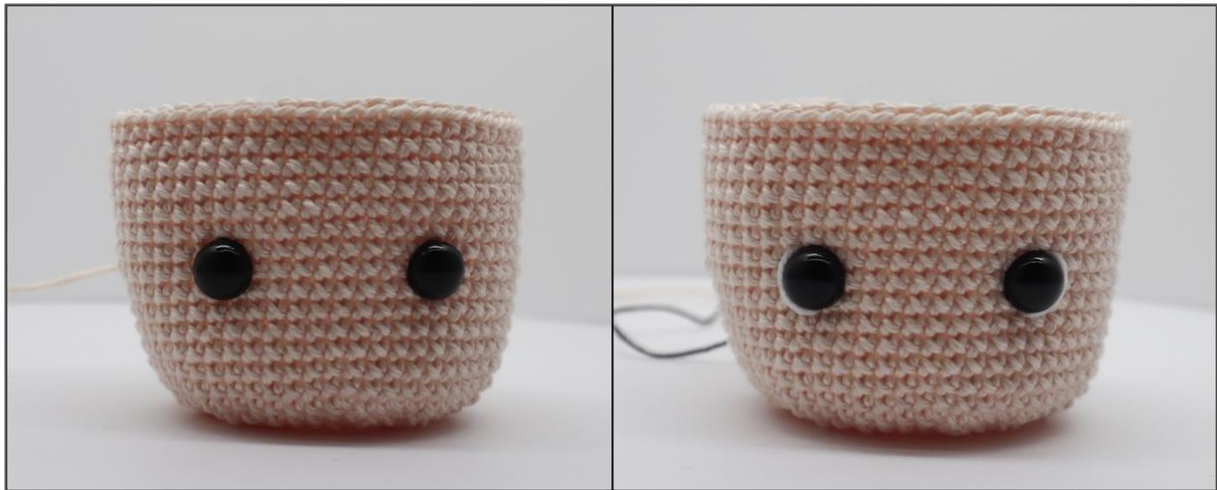
Rnd 25-30 sc in each st around, (54)



Pause here to insert the eyes and embroider the face and crochet the ears:

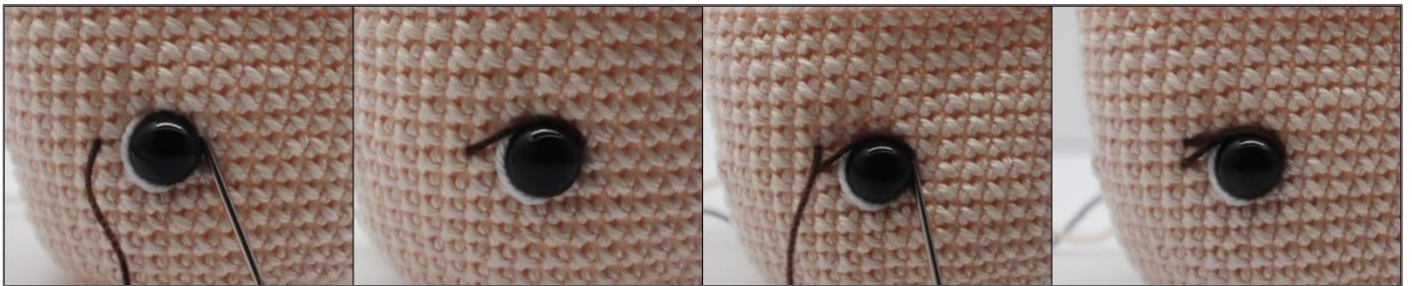
Eyes

Firstly, insert your safety eyes and use the white yarn to embroider round the eyes as shown on photo below.

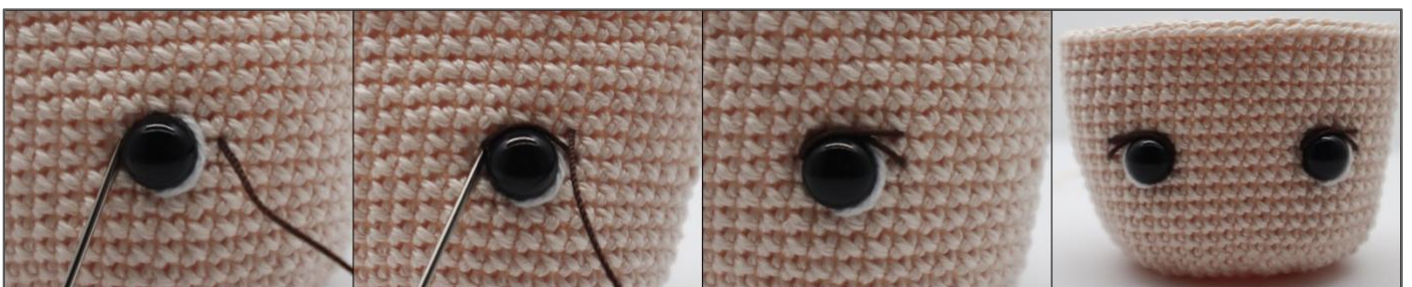


Use Sweet Treat colour 162 Black Coffee to embroider the eyes/eyebrows. Follow the photos below:

Right Eye

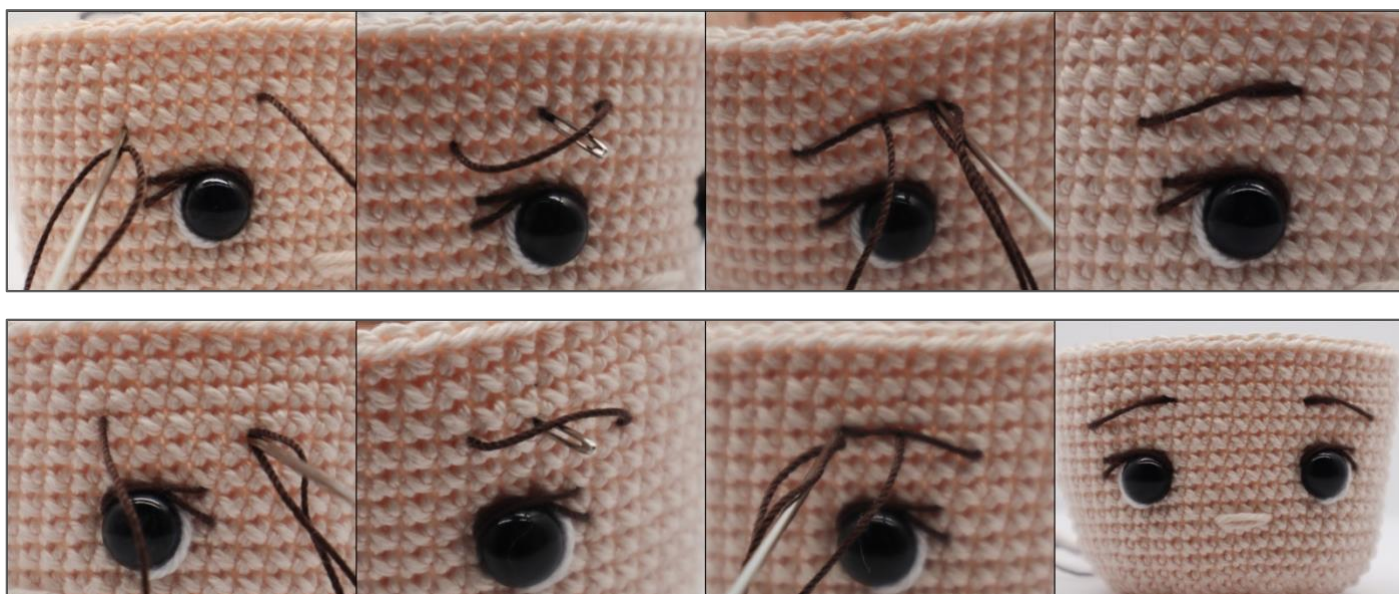


Left Eye



Nose

The nose is worked across 3 stitches between rows 20 and 21. Thread your needle and bring the needle out where the yellow dot is, back in where the red dot is then back out where the yellow dot is 3 times. Knot the ends together inside the head. See photos below:

**Eyebrows****Ears**

The ears are worked into the dc stitches you made on round 23. Insert hook (see photo below) pull up a loop and ch1, make 6 hdc, fasten off, use a needle to sew the tail ends inside the head and knot together.





Start stuffing the head, keep stuffing firmly as you go

Rnd 31-33 sc in each st around, (54)

Rnd 34 *sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog* 6 times, (48)

Rnd 35 *sc in next 6 st, sc2tog* 6 times, (42)

Rnd 36 *sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog* 6 times, (36)

Rnd 37 *sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog* 6 times, (30)

Rnd 38 *sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog* 6 times, (24)

Rnd 39 *sc in next 2 sts, sc2tog* 6 times, (18)

Rnd 40 *sc in next st, sc2tog* 6 times, (12)

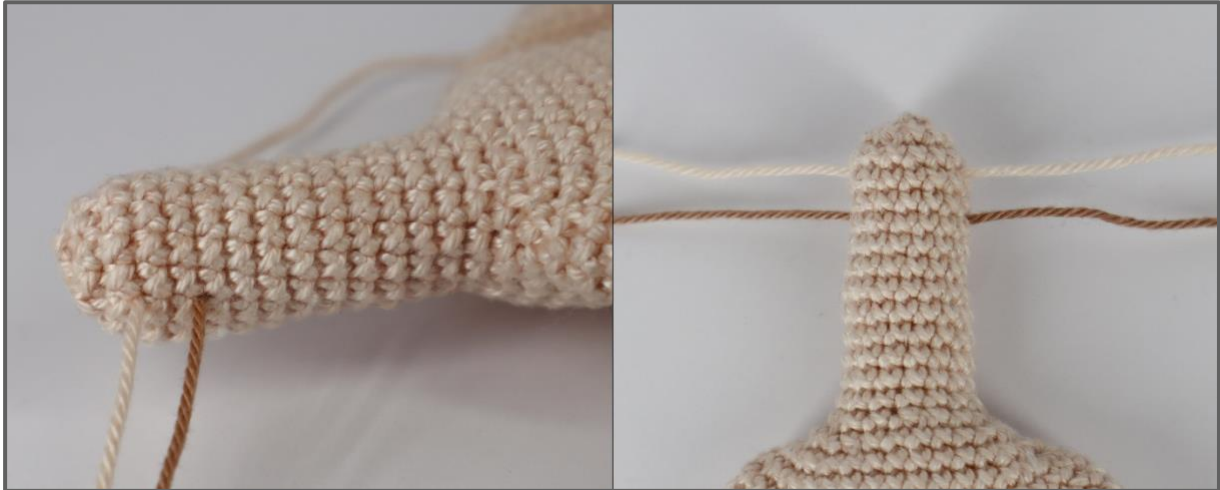
Fasten off, leave a long tail to close the hole but don't do it yet.

Connecting the body to the head

You will need a long sharp needle for this part. Cut 2 pieces of cotton yarn approx. 50cm long. I have used 2 different colours.

Using the needle sew the 2 pieces of cotton through the neck stump, the first at between rows 35 and 36, the second approx 2 rows down:





Then sew each strand through the neck cavity and up through the top of the head.

Sew 2 through one side and 2 through the other in the spots I have highlighted in red (it doesn't have to be exact just roughly in that area):



Push the head onto the neck stump and pull all the stands tightly. Then knot the paired strands together (so the two skin ends are tied together and the two brown ends are tied together). I made several knots in each pair. Hide the ends inside the head. Use a needle to thread the tail end through the front loops of the remaining stitches and pull the hole closed. Weave in ends.





Hair

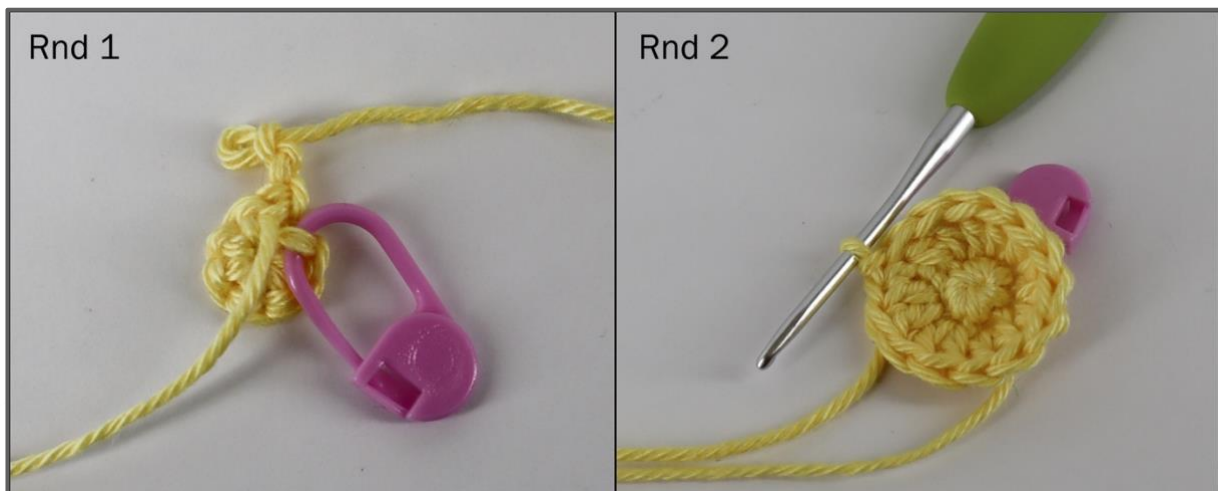
Start with 2mm, colour Catona 522 (Primrose)

Use the standard single crochet

Wig Base

Rnd 1 Create a magic ring, make 7 sc into the ring, join to the front loop, (place a stitch marker in the back loop), (7)

Rnd 2 (FLO)ch2, dc[^] in same st, dc[^] in each st around, join, (14)

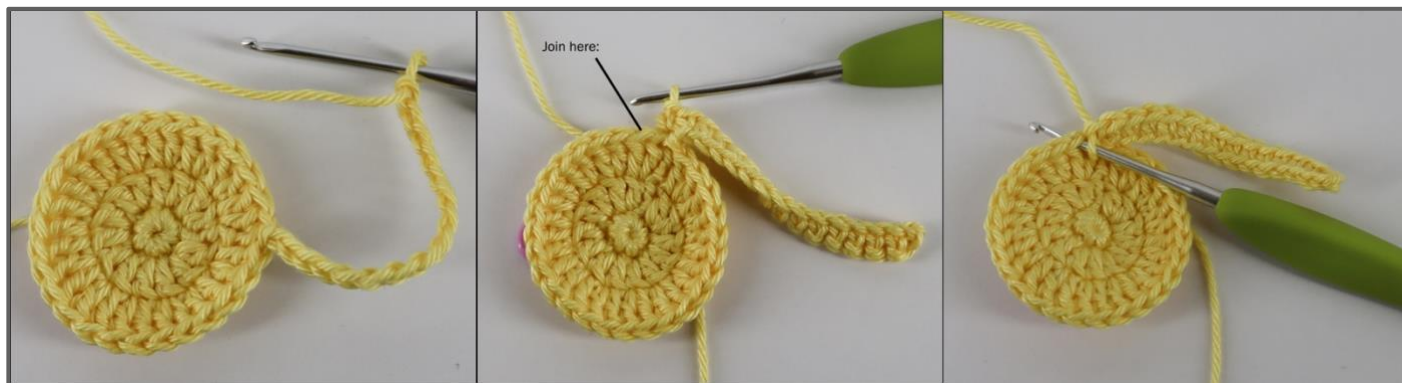


Rnd 3 ch2, dc[^] in each st around, join, (28)



Do not fasten off you will now work in rows, joining every other row with a slip stitch to round 3 of base. When crocheting into the chain stitches work in the "back bumps". See notes for a diagram of the back bumps.

Row 1 ch16 sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 14 sts, sl into next st on row 3 of wig base, ch1 turn (15)



Row 2 (work in FLO) sc in next 15 sts, ch1 turn, (15)



Row 3 (work in FLO) sc in same st, sc in next 14 sts, sl into next st on row 3 of wig base, ch1 turn (15)

Row 4 (work in FLO) sc in next 15 sts, (15)

Row 5-22 Repeat rows 3 and 4

Row 23 (work in FLO) sc in same st, sc in next 14 sts, sl into next st on row 3 of wig base, sl into next st on row 3 of wig base, (15)





Continue to make the loose strands:

Strand 1 ch12, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 10 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (11)

Strand 2 ch14, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 12 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (13)

Strand 3 ch19, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 17 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (18)

Strand 4 ch14, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 12 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (11)

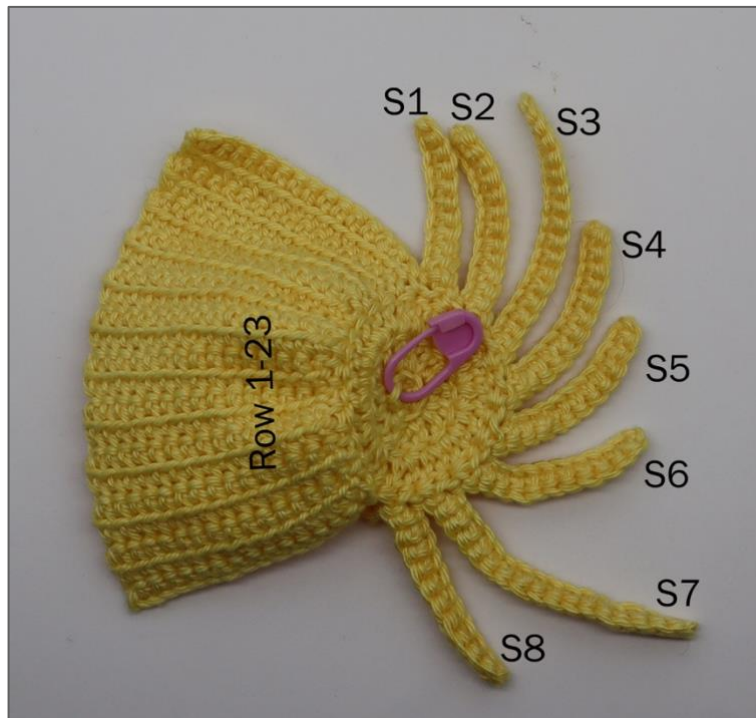
Strand 5 ch13, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 11 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (12)

Strand 6 ch12, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 10 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (11)

Strand 7 ch18, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 16 sts, **sk next** st, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (17)

Strand 8 ch12, sc in 2nd ch, sc in next 10 sts, **sk next** st on base, sl into **next** st on row 3 of wig base (11)





Top layer/Bun

Join yarn to a loop on row 1 of wig base

Strand 1 ch100, sl into **same** loop on base, (99)

Strand 2-7 ch100 sl st to **next** loop on base (99)



Cut a piece of yarn and use it to tie the 7 strands together:



Attaching the wig

Secure wig base of hair into position on the head using pins, wrong side facing up.

Pin Round 1 of the hair wig on the centre of the head.

Rows 1-25 are positioned at the back of the head

Pin Strand 1 above the left ear. Pin Strand 8 above the right ear.

When you are happy with the position you can sew or glue in place using fabric/hot glue.





Next pin strands 2,3 and 7 in position as shown in the photographs below and sew in place:



Now twist the strands of the top layer and roll to form a bun on top of the head, when you are happy with the position sew in place.



Hair Tie

Hook 2mm, colour 205 (Apfel)

Row 1, ch101, sl in 2nd ch, sl in each st along, (100) Fasten off, tie around the bun.

Sew strand 6 to the side next to strand 7



Wings (make 2)

Hook 2mm, skin colour 106 (Snow White)

Small wing

Rnd 1 Create a magic ring, make 6 sc in ring, (6)

Rnd 2 sc[^] in each st around, (12)

Rnd 3 *sc in next 3 st, sc[^] in next st* 3 times, (15)

Rnd 4-5 sc in each st around, (15) Fasten off



Large wing

Rnd 1 Create a magic ring, make 5 sc in ring, (5)

Rnd 2 sc^ in next st, sc in next 4 sts, (6)

Rnd 3 sc in each st around, (6)

Rnd 4 sc in next 5 sts, sc^ in next st, (7)

Rnd 5 sc^ in next st, sc in next 6 sts, (8)

Rnd 6 sc in next 7 sts, sc^ in next st, (9)

Rnd 7 sc^ in next st, sc in next 8 sts, (10)

Rnd 8 sc in next 9 sts, sc^ in next st, (11)

Rnd 9 sc in each st around, (11)

Rnd 10 sc^ in next st, sc in next 10 sts, (12)

Rnd 11 *sc^ in next st, sc in next 5 sts* 2 times, (14)

Rnd 12 sc^ in next st, sc in next 12 sts, sc^ in next st, (16)

Rnd 13 sc in each st around, (16)

Rnd 14 sc^ in next st, sc in next 14 sts, sc^ in next st, (18)

Rnd 15-21 sc in each st around, (18)

Rnd 22 *sc in next 7 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, (16)

Rnd 23 *sc in next 6 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, (14)

Rnd 24 *sc in next 5 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, (12)

Rnd 25 *sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, (10)

Do not fasten off, you will now crochet the large and small wings together



Rnd 26 (small wing) *sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog* 3 times, (**Large Wing**) sc in next 10 sts, (22)

Rnd 27 *sc in next 4 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, sc in next 10 sts, (20)

Rnd 28 sc in next 8 sts, sc2tog, *sc in next 3 sts, sc2tog* 2 times, (17)

Rnd 29 sc2tog 8 times, sc in next st, (9) Fasten off, leave a long tail for sewing.



Pin the wings in place at the back of the doll. When you are happy with the position use the tail ends to sew in place.



Lastly apply some blush across the nose and cheeks of your doll and your finished!
