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#### MATERIAL

Yarn: • Hobbii Honey Bunny & Snuggle Solid (super bulky chenille yarn)

Scheepjes Catona (sport weight yarn)

DMC Happy Cotton (DK weight yarn)

(the color code will be precise for each animal)

Hook: 3.75 mm (main hook - use main hook throughout, unless otherwise stated)

2.5 mm

2 safety eyes Ø 6 mm for each animal

Stuffing (polyfill, cotton wool, etc.), needle for sewing, scissors, pins, pink blush for the cheeks



#### **SPECIAL STITCHES**

#### Bobble Stitch (made of 3 hdc)

Yarn over, insert hook in stitch or space specified and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook) (image 1); [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch or space and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 2 times (4 loops remain on hook) (image 2), yarn over and draw through all 4 loops on hook (image 3).




## Bobble Stitch (made of 4 hdc) - video https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=4leBWB54t34

Yarn over, insert hook in stitch or space specified and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook) (image 1); [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch or space and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 3 times (5 loops remain on hook) (image 2), yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook (image 3).



#### Bobble Stitch (made of 5 hdc)

Yarn over, insert hook in stitch or space specified and pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook (2 loops remain on hook) (image 1); [yarn over, insert hook in same stitch or space and pull up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops on hook] 4 times (6 loops remain on hook) (image 2), yarn over and draw through all 6 loops on hook (image 3).



#### **HOW TO READ MY PATTERN**

Here are some explanations on how to follow instructions:

## Example 1

Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) 6 times [24]

To work round 4, you need to repeat the instructions found between the brackets (2 sc, 1 inc) six times. You start by working a single crochet in each of the next 2 stitches and then work 2 single crochets into the next stitch (increase made). This then gets repeated for another five times. At the end of the round, you can check the stitch count as you should now have 24 single crochets.

#### Example 2

**Rnds 10-16 (7 rnds):** 1 sc in each st around [35]

This reads that the rounds from 10 to 16 will all have the same instructions. It also notifies you that there are seven rounds where this happens. The instruction is to work a single crochet in each stitch around for each round. The stitch count at the end of each of the seven rounds should be 35 single crochets.

#### Example 3

**Rnd 11:** 26 sc; Yarn A: 2 sc; Yarn B: 26 sc [54]

To crochet round 11, you will alternate the two colors A and B, check the material box for the reference of each yarn.

#### > **Rnd 11**: 26 sc

To start round 11, continue with the yarn from the previous round, then make a single crochet in each of the next 26 stitches. At the last step of the 26<sup>th</sup> stitch, change to the yarn A.

#### > Yarn A: 2 sc

With Yarn A, make a single crochet in each of the next 2 stitches. At the last step of the 2<sup>nd</sup> stitch, change to the Yarn B.

#### > Yarn B: 26 sc

With Yarn B, make a single crochet in each of the next 26 stitches.

At the end of rnd 11, you will have 54 stitches.

#### **NOTE**

When crochet with chenille yarn: instead of magic ring, ch 2 then start in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, video: <a href="https://youtu.be/0MKqcUIMpBA?si=j12mngP6aBl8lEsT&t=125">https://youtu.be/0MKqcUIMpBA?si=j12mngP6aBl8lEsT&t=125</a>

Gauge: 4 stitches and 3 rows = 2.5 cm (1 inch), this information is important as it may affect to the color change.

Crochet in spiral, unless otherwise stated. I always precise the moment I start stuffing. If there is no mention about stuffing, it means we don't need to stuff that part.

The size of the toy will vary, depending on the yarn used. If you use the same materials as me, the finished size is **10 cm**.



## **LET'S START!**

BEE

Yarn: Hobbii Baby Snuggle Solid - Cream 02, Black 09, Yellow 07 (lighter) or 37,

DMC Happy Cotton – Black 775. Hook: 3.75 mm

## **HEAD AND BODY (begin with Yellow)**

Rnd 1: 7 sc into a magic ring [7]

**Rnd 2:** 7 inc [14]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) 7 times [21]

**Rnd 4:** (6 sc, 1 inc) 3 times [24]

**Rnds 5-6 (2 rnds):** 1 sc in each st around [24]

**Rnd 7:** (7 sc, 1 inc) 3 times [27]

Rnd 8: Work in black loops only, Black, 1 sc in each st around [27]

Rnd 9: Yellow, 1 sc in each st around [27]

**Rnd 10:** Yellow, (8 sc, 1 inc) 3 times [30]

Rnd 11: Black, 1 sc in each st around [30]

Fasten off Black yarn, continue with Yellow yarn.

If you use safety eyes, insert them between rnds 5 & 6, 4 st apart.

Start stuffing, adding more as you go.

Rnd 12: (3 sc, 1 dec) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 13:** (1 sc, 1 dec) 8 times [16]

**Rnd 14:** 8 dec [8]

Finish stuffing. Fasten off and close the remaining st, weaving in the ends.

Using DMC Happy Cotton Black, embroider the mouth on rnd 6, between two eyes.

Using makeup blush, add color for the cheeks (image 1).

## WINGS (Cream)

Mark a st on rnd 8, about 4 st apart from the eye, this is the place of the first wing (image 2).

Ch 2 (image 3), insert the hook into the marked st (image 4), sl st, continue to crochet on

the ch (image 5), 1 sc, {4 sc} in the last ch, continue on other side of the ch (image 6), 1 sc.

Fasten off, sew some st to secure the wing (image 7).

Make another wing in the same way, just below the first one (image 8).

Repeat on the other side of the body to make two more wings (image 9).




## **ANTENNAES (Black)**

Mark 2 st on rnd 2, 6 st apart, these are the place of the ears (image 10).

Insert the hook to the first marked st and take the black yarn (image 11): ch 3 (image 12), starting in the  $2^{nd}$  ch from hook, 2 sl st.

Fasten off, sew some st to secure the antennae (images 13, 14).

Repeat on other side to make the second antennae (image 15).





PIG

Main part: Hobbii Honey Bunny – Pink 03 (or 50), Hobbii Snuggle Solid – Cream 02;

hook 3.75 mm

Snout: Scheepjes Catona – Apricot 524 (or Tulip 222), Snow White 106; hook 2.5 mm

## **HEAD AND BODY (begin with Pink)**

Rnds 1-7: work the same as rnds 1-7 of Bee

Rnd 8: 8 sc, 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc), 2 sc; Cream: 4 sc; Baby Blue: 2 sc, 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc), 9 sc [27]

**Rnd 9:** 10 sc; Cream: 6 sc; Baby Blue: 11 sc [27]

**Rnd 10:** 8 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc; Cream: 6 sc; Baby Blue: 1 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc [30]

Rnd 11: 10 sc, 1 bobble st (made of 4 hdc); Cream: 6 sc; Baby Blue: 1 bobble st (made of 4 hdc), 12 sc [30]

If you use safety eyes, insert them between rnds 5 & 6, 3 st apart, with the cream part of body is at the center. Start stuffing, adding more as you go.

**Rnd 12:** (3 sc, 1 dec) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 13:** (1 sc, 1 dec) 8 times [16]

**Rnd 14:** 8 dec [8]

Finish stuffing. Fasten off and close the remaining st, weaving in the ends (image 1).

## **SNOUT (Scheepjes Catona yarn and 2.5mm hook)**

Using Apricot 524 (or Tulip 222), ch 3, starting from the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1 inc, 1 sc, {4 sc} in the last ch; continue to work on other side of th ch, 1 sc, 1 inc.

Fasten off and make an <u>invisible join</u>, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using Snow White 106, embroider the nostrils on the snout (image 2).

Sew the snout on rnd 6, between two eyes (image 3).



## EARS (Pink)

Mark 2 st on each side of the head, at rnd 2 and 4, these are the place of the ears (image 4).

**The left ear:** insert the hook into the marked st on rnd 4 (image 5), ch 4, starting in the second ch from hook, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 dc, insert the hook into the marked st on rnd 2 (image 6), sl st. Fasten off, sew some st to secure the ear (image 7).

The right ear: work as the left ear, but insert the hook into the marked st on rnd 2 first (image 8) then finish with a sl st into the marked st on rnd 4 (image 9).

Using makeup blush, add color for the cheeks and inner ears (image 10).

## TAIL (Pink)

Insert the hook to the center st of rnd 11 of the back (image 11): ch 4, starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 3 inc. Fasten off, sew some st to secure the tail (image 12).







#### COW

Main part: Hobbii Honey Bunny – White 01, Beige 05, Brown 14 (or Black 124);

hook 3.75 mm

Snout: DMC Happy cotton – Orange 793 (or Pink 764), Black 775; hook 2.5 mm

## **HEAD AND BODY (begin with White)**

**Rnd 1:** 7 sc into a magic ring [7]

Rnd 2: Brown: 1 inc, {brown: 1 sc, beige: 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc)} in next st, Brown: 1

inc; White: 1 inc, {White: 1 sc, beige: 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc)} in next st, White: 2 inc [14]

Rnd 3: Brown: (1 sc, 1 inc) 3 times; White: (1 sc, 1 inc) 4 times [21]

Rnd 4: 1 sc; Brown: 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc; White: 4 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc [24]

**Rnd 5:** 2 sc; Brown: 7 sc; White: 15 sc [24]

**Rnd 6:** 3 sc; Brown: 5 sc; White: 16 sc [24]

Fasten off Brown yarn, continue with White yarn.

**Rnd 7:** (7 sc, 1 inc) 3 times [27]

Rnd 8: 8 sc; Beige: 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc); White: 8 sc; Beige: 1 bobble st (made of 3

hdc); White: 9 sc [27]

**Rnd 9:** 16 sc; Brown: 4 sc; White: 7 sc [27]

**Rnd 10:** 8 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc; Brown: 2 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc; White: 5 sc, 1 inc [30]

Rnd 11: 10 sc; Beige: 1 bobble st (made of 4 hdc); White: 5 sc; Brown: 1 sc; Beige: 1 bobble st

(made of 4 hdc); Brown: 5 sc; White: 7 sc [30]

Fasten off Beige and Brown yarns, continue with White yarn. If you use safety eyes, insert them between rnds 5 & 6, 3 st apart (image 1). Start stuffing, adding more as you go.

**Rnd 12:** (3 sc, 1 dec) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 13:** (1 sc, 1 dec) 8 times [16]


**Rnd 14:** 8 dec [8]

Finish stuffing. Fasten off and close the remaining st, weaving in the ends.

#### **EARS**

The left ear: Ch 2 (image 2), insert the hook into the st below the horn (image 3), sl st, continue to crochet on the ch (image 4), 1 sc, {4 sc} in the last ch, continue on other side of the ch, 1 sc. Fasten off, sew some st to secure the wing (image 5).

The right ear: Using the Brown yarn, make the right ear on the other side of the head in the same way with the left ear (image 6).



## **TAIL (Brown)**

Insert the hook to the center st of rnd 11 of the back (image 7): ch 4, starting in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook, 1 hdc, 2 sc. Fasten off, sew some st to secure the tail (image 8).

## **SNOUT (DMC Happy Cotton yarn and 2.5mm hook)**

Rnd 1: 7 sc into a magic ring [7]

Rnd 2: 4 inc, 1 sc [7] stop here, leaving 2 st unworked.

Fasten off and make an invisible join, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using Black 775, embroider the nostrils on the snout.

Sew the snout on rnds 6 & 7, between two eyes. Using makeup blush, add color for the cheeks and inner ear (image 3).





#### **FROG**

Yarn: Hobbii Baby Snuggle Solid – Cream 02, Blue 05 (or Green 35); Pink 03 DMC Happy cotton – Black 775. 2 safety eyes 8 mm. Hook: 3.75 mm

The tiny frog is made with Chenille amigurumi yarn of Circulo, 3 mm hook and 2 safety eyes 6 mm.

## **HEAD AND BODY (begin with Blue)**

**Rnd 1:** 7 sc into a magic ring [7]

**Rnd 2:** 7 inc [14]

**Rnd 3:** 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc, 1 bobble st (made of 5 hdc), 1 inc, (1 sc,

1 inc) 2 times, 1 bobble st (made of 5 hdc), (1 inc, 1 sc) 2 times [21]

**Rnd 4:** (6 sc, 1 inc) 3 times [24]

Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st around [24]

Insert each safety eye into the bobble st of rnd 3. Start stuffing, adding more as you go.

**Rnd 6:** 10 sc; Cream: 4 sc; Blue: 10 sc [24]

**Rnd 7:** 7 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc; Cream: 6 sc; Blue: 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc [27]

Rnd 8: 8 sc, 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc); Cream: 8 sc; Blue: 1 bobble st (made of 3 hdc); 9 sc [27]

**Rnd 9:** 9 sc; Cream: 8 sc; Blue: 10 sc [27]

**Rnd 10:** 8 sc, 1 inc; Cream: 8 sc; Blue: 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 inc [30]

Rnd 11: 10 sc, 1 bobble st (made of 4 hdc); Cream: 6 sc; Baby Blue: 1 bobble st (made of 4 hdc),

12 sc [30]. Fasten off the Cream yarn, continue with Blue yarn.

**Rnd 12:** (3 sc, 1 dec) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 13:** (1 sc, 1 dec) 8 times [16]

**Rnd 14:** 8 dec [8]

Finish stuffing. Fasten off and close the remaining st, weaving in the ends.

Using DMC Happy Cotton Black 775, embroider the mouth on rnd 3, between 2 eyes.

Using Pink yarn, embroider a small line at rnd 4 on each side of the face.

#### LAST STEP!
