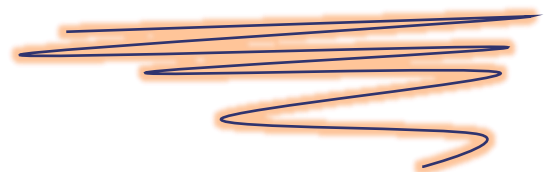


# *Pocket Dog Crochet pattern*

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*Abbreviations:*

- *CH - chain*
- *ST, STS - stitch, stitches*
- *MR - magic ring*
- *SC - single crochet*
- *SL ST - slip stitch*
- *INC - increase (two sc crocheted into one st)*
- *DEC - decrease (two sc crocheted together)*

*Notes:*

The pattern contains detailed step-by-step instructions with lots of photos and videos to help you crochet a cute puppy.

Each video has a QR-code - when you print a pattern, you just need to scan the QR-code on your mobile phone to watch the video.

Level of difficulty: Intermediate

Size: The size of the Dog may vary depending on the yarn used.

If you use the same materials as me, the finished product is 12 cm / 4.7 inches tall.

## *Materials and Tools:*

- *YarnArt Jeans (50g / 160m) – 55% cotton/ 40% acrylic:  
Light beige №07- main color  
white color - №62- main color  
Anthracite №28- nose color*
- *One pair of 10mm safety eyes*
- *Hook size 2mm*
- *Stuffing (polyfill , cotton etc.)*
- *Scissors , needle for sewing , pins*

## Description.

### Head:

Start crocheting with white yarn.

Rnd1. 6 sc in a MR

Rnd2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd3. (1 sc, inc)\*6 (18)

Rnd4. (2 sc, inc)\*6 (24)

Rnd5. (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)

Rnd6. (4 sc, inc)\*6 (36)

Rnd7. 36 sc

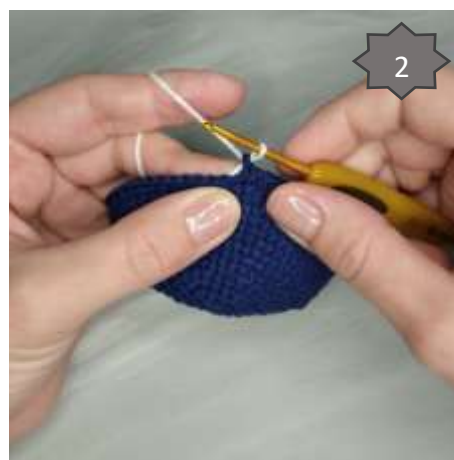
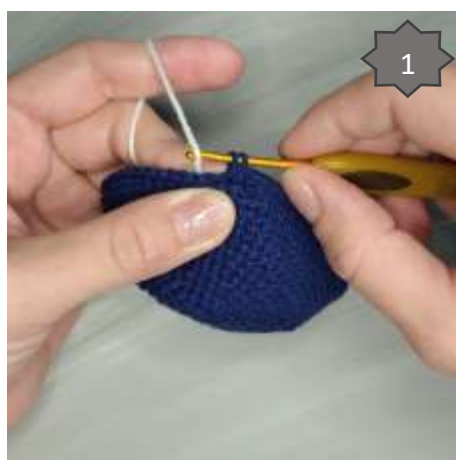
Rnd8. 24 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*3, 6 sc (39)

Rnd9. 24 sc, (2 sc, inc)\*3, 6 sc (42)

Rnd10-15. (6 rnds) sc in all 42 st. (42)

At the end of Rnd 16, change to light beige yarn.

In the description, we will indicate the color of the yarn with the letters W- white yarn, B- light beige. The last loop of color is crocheted like this:





Please refer to the photos at page 5 (photo 1 – photo 4) for color change techniques. At the last sc of rnd 16, do not yarn over. With 2 loops on the hook, pick up light beige yarn, yarn over and continue working according to the pattern.

*Video "Thread Change. Crochet a spot"*



After each color change, cut yarn and secure with a knot (as seen in photo).

Rnd16. W-36 sc, B-6 sc (42) We continue to crochet with beige yarn.

Rnd17. B-7 sc, W-6 sc, B-11 sc, W-12, B-6 (42)

Rnd18. B-8 sc, W-4 sc, B-12 sc, W-12, B-6 (42)

Rnd19-22. (4 rnds) B-8 sc, W-4 sc, B-13 sc, W-10, B-7 (42)

Rnd23. B-8 sc, W-4 sc, B-12 sc, W-12, B-6 (42)

Rnd24. B-7 sc, W-6 sc, B-10 sc, W-14, B-5 (42)

Rnd25. B-7 sc, W-6 sc, B-10 sc, W-15, B-4 (42)

Rnd26. B-5 sc, W-10 sc, B-7 sc, W-18, B-2 (42)

Rnd27. B-5 sc, W- dec, 5 sc, dec, 1 sc, B-4 sc, dec, 1 sc, W-4 sc, dec, (5 sc, dec)\*2 (36)

Rnd28. B-2 sc, dec, 1 sc, W-3 sc, dec, 3 sc, B-1 sc, dec, 3 sc, W-1 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*2, 2 sc (30)

*Insert safety eyes* between Rnd 20 & 21, 10 st apart.

Secure the beige yarn, weave in end.

We continue to crochet with white yarn.

Stuff the head with filler.

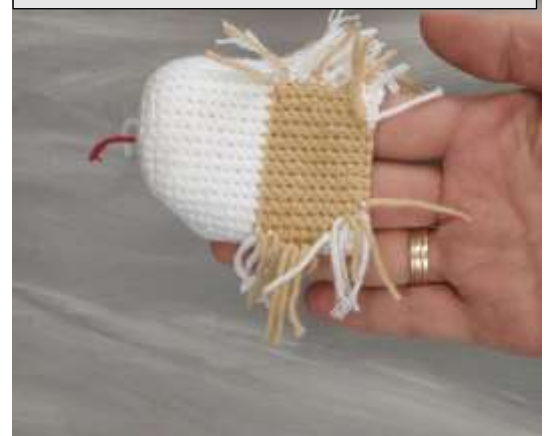
Rnd29. (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

Rnd30. (2 sc, dec)\*6 (18)

Rnd31. (1 sc, dec)\*6 (12)

Stuff the head firmly with filler.

The wrong side will look like this.



Rnd32. 6 dec (6)

Secure the yarn, weave in end.

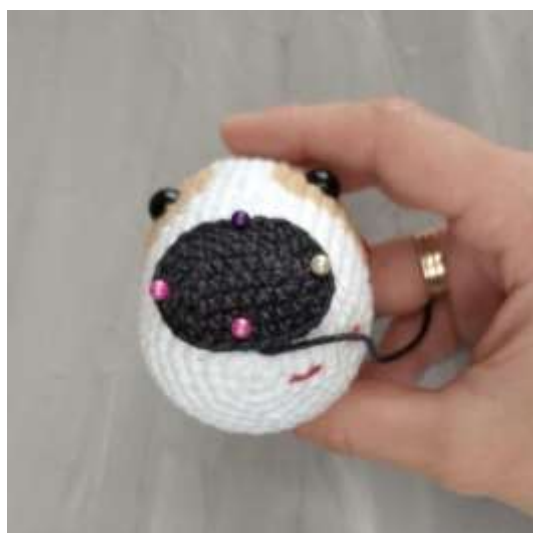
*Nose:* (anthracite yarn)

Make ch6, crochet from the second ch from hook:

1. inc, 3 sc, 3 sc into the last ch, along another side of the chain: 3 sc, inc (13)
2. 1 sc, inc, 3 sc, 3 inc, 4 sc, inc (18)
3. 1 sc, inc, 4 sc, (1 sc, inc)\*3, 4 sc, inc, 1 sc (23)
4. 23 sc, 1 slst.

Fasten off and leave a yarn tail for sewing.

The nose is sewn in the 2nd and 10th rows of the head.



Sew the nose on the sc, not the loops. So the seam will be invisible



With the tip of the yarn, make one stitch from the bottom edge of the nose to the center down.

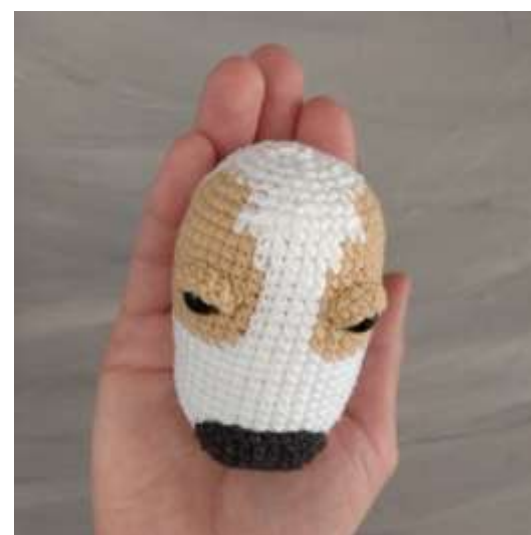


*Eyelids on the eyes:* (make two, beige yarn)

Ch 7, starting from the second ch from hook, sc in the next 6 ch.

Fasten off and leave a yarn tail for sewing.

Now we sew the eyelids on the eyes. We sew it so that the eyelid closes the eye a little. As shown in the photo.





### *Ears:* (make 2, beige yarn)

Make ch7, crochet from the second ch from hook:

Rnd1. inc, 4 sc, 2 sc into the last ch, along the other side of the chain: 4 sc, inc (14)

Rnd2. 14 sc (14)

Rnd3. inc, 6 sc, inc, 6 sc (16)

Rnd4. Inc, 15 (17)

Rnd5. 1 sc, inc, 15 sc (18)

Rnd6. 2 sc, inc, 15 sc (19)

Rnd7. 18 sc, inc (20)

Rnd8. Inc, 19 sc (21)

Rnd9. 20 sc, inc (22)

Rnd10. Inc, 21 sc (23)

Rnd11-12. (2 rnds) sc in all 23 st. (23)

Rnd13. 3 sc, dec, (4 sc, dec)\*3 (19)

Rnd14. 19 sc

Rnd15. Dec, 15 sc, dec (17)

Rnd16. Dec, 13 sc, dec (15)

Rnd17. 15 sc

Rnd18. (2 sc, dec)\*3, 1 sc, dec (11)

Rnd19. 11 sc

Rnd20. Dec, 8 sc, 1 dec with the last st of rnd 20 and the first st of next round.

Rnd21. Fold the ear in half and crochet 4sc through both sides.

Fasten off and leave a yarn tail for sewing.

We sew the ears between the 25th and 26th rows of the head. As shown in the photo.



## Arms - Legs: (make 4)

Start crocheting with white yarn.

Stuff arms with filler up to half the arm's length at rnd 7.

Rnd1. 6 sc in a MR

Rnd2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd3. (2 sc, inc)\*4 (16)

Rnd4-5. (2 rnds) sc in all 16 st. (16)

Rnd6. (2 sc, dec)\*4 (12)

Rnd7. 12 sc

Rnd8. Crochet with beige yarn 12 sc

Rnd9. (2 sc, dec)\*3 (9)

Rnd10-11. (2 rnds) sc in all 9 st. (9)

Rnd12. 9 sc +1 sc

Rnd13. Fold in half and work 4 sc through two layers.

Fasten off.



## Body:

Start crocheting with white yarn.

Rnd1. 6 sc in a MR

Rnd2. 6 inc (12)

Rnd3. (1 sc, inc)\*6 (18)

Rnd4. (2 sc, inc)\*6 (24)

Rnd5. (3 sc, inc)\*6 (30)

Rnd6. (4 sc, inc)\*6 (36)

Rnd7. (5 sc, inc)\*6 (42)

Then we crochet the legs into the body & we will crochet a spot on the back, changing the white and beige yarn.

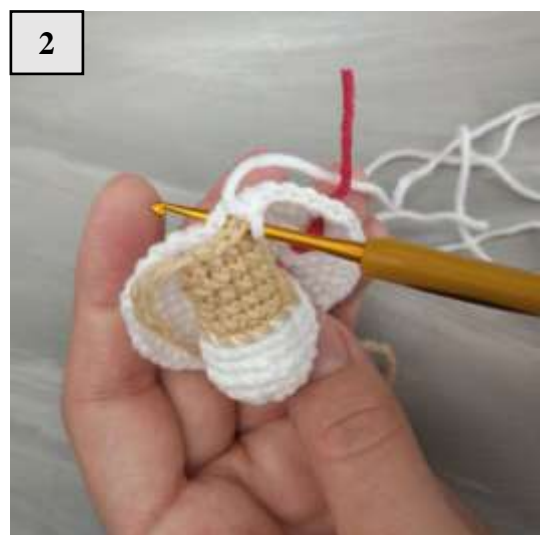
Rnd8. 6 sc, 4 sc with the leg, 3 sc, 4 sc with the leg, 12 sc, B-8 sc, W-5 sc (42)  
(See the photo 1-6 on page 10-11)

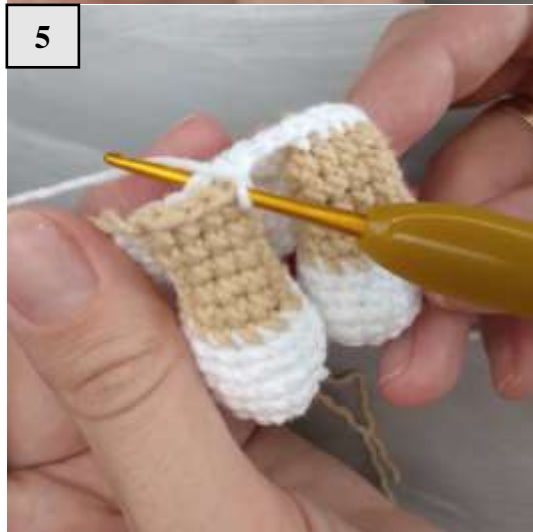
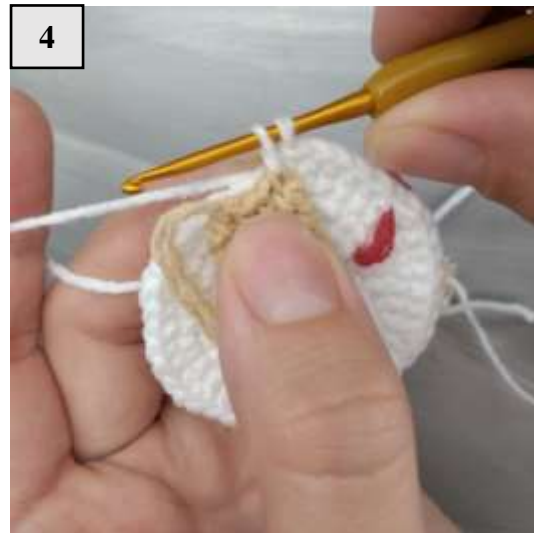
Rnd9. W-29 sc, B-9 sc, W-4 sc (42)

Rnd10-11. (2 rnds) W-27 sc, B-13 sc, W-2 sc (42)

Rnd12. W-26 sc, B-16 sc (42)

Rnd13-15. (3 rnds) W-22 sc, B-20 sc (42)





Fix the yarn from the legs with knots on the back of the body.

Rnd16-17. (2 rnds) W-21 sc, B-19 sc, W-2 sc (42)

Rnd18. W-21 sc, B-18 sc, W-3 sc (42)

Rnd19. W-23 sc, B-16 sc, W-3 sc (42)

Rnd20. W-12 sc, dec, 8 sc, B-4 sc, dec, 10 sc, W-2 sc, dec (39)

Rnd21. W-19 sc, B-15 sc, W-5 sc (39)

Stuff the body firmly with filler.

Rnd22. W-11 sc, dec, 7 sc, B-5 sc, dec, 8 sc, W-2 sc, dec (36)

Then we crochet the arms into the body.

The arms should be symmetrical with the legs. Perhaps due to the displacement of the loops, you need to crochet + - 2sc

Rnd23. 3 sc, 4 sc with the arm, 3 sc, 4 sc with the arm, 4 sc, B-14 sc, W-4 sc (36)

Rnd24. W-(4 sc, dec)\*3, 3 sc, B-1 sc, dec, 4 sc, dec, 1 sc, W-3 sc, dec (30)





Beige yarn fasten off.

Rnd25. (3 sc, dec)\*6 (24)

Rnd26. 24 sc

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Stuff the body firmly with filler.

**Now we sew the head (from Rnd 17th to Rnd 25th) to the body of the dog.**



## Tail:

Start crocheting with white yarn.

Stuff tail with filler up to half the tail's length at rnd 5.

Rnd1. 6 sc in a MR

Rnd2. (2 sc, inc)\*2 (8)

Rnd3. (3 sc, inc)\*2 (10)

Rnd4-5. (2 rnds) sc in all 10 st. (10)

Rnd6. Crochet with beige yarn 10 sc

Rnd7-10. (4 rnds) sc in all 10 st. (10)

Rnd11. (3 sc, dec)\*2 (8)

Rnd12. 1 sc, Fold in half and work 4 sc through two layers.

Fasten off, leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the tail between Rnd 6th to 10th at the back of the body.
