ABBREVIATIONS

- 5 mm crochet hook
- Bulky (5) yarn
 - · Brown
 - · Yellow
 - · Pink
- DK black yarn
- 7 mm safety eyes
- Polyester fiber fill
- · Tapestry needle
- Scissors

mr magic ring

ch chain

st(s) stitch(es)

slst(s) slip stitch(es)

sc single crochet

inc increase

dec decrease

BO 4-dc bobble

BLO back loop only

NOTES

You may sell finished items using this pattern, but please credit me as the designer!

HEAD & BODY

START WITH BROWN YARN

R1. 6 sc in mr (6)

Change to yellow yarn

R2. BLO sc all around (6)

R3. sc all around (6)

R4. inc x 6 (12)

R5. [sc, inc] \times 6 (18)

R6-11. sc all around, for 6 rounds (18)

R12. 6 sc, *ch 10. In the 3rd ch from the hook, make a BO. 7 slsts down the chain. Slst into the st where the chain started.*

7 sc. Repeat instructions between the ** to make the 2nd arm. 5 sc to end the round. (18)



BODY (CONTINUE)

R13. sc all around, skipping the arms by working under them so they are outside the body when done. (18)

If you're using safety eyes, you can put them in front of the face now, between rounds 8 and 9, with 3 sts apart.

R14. dec, 6 sc, 2 inc, 6 sc, dec (18)

R15. sc all around (18)

Start stuffing the body and continue as you go.

R16-17. sc all around, for 2 rounds (18)

R18. [2 sc, dec, 3 sc, dec] x 2 (14)

BODY (CONTINUE)

R19. 5 sc, *ch 13. In the 3rd ch from the hook, make a BO. 10 slsts down the chain. Slst into the st where the chain started.*

7 sc. Repeat instructions between the ** to make the 2nd leg. 2 sc to end the round. (14)

If the legs are not in-line with the arms, you can add 1 or 2 sc at the beginning of the round and subtract the same number of sc from the end of the round.

R20. sc all around, skipping the legs by working under them so they are outside the body when done. (14)

BODY (CONTINUE)

R21. $[5 \text{ sc}, \text{dec}] \times 2$ (12)

Stuff the body before closing.

R22. dec x 6 (6)

Fasten off and cut the yarn. To close the remaining gap, use a tapestry needle to take the yarn tail through the front loops of the last 6 sts and then pull tight to close.



FACE DETAILS

Use black DK yarn:

- · Sew a mouth on round 9 in front of the face.
- On round 7, sew two lines above the eyes for eyebrows. Double over the eyebrows to make them thicker!

Use pink bulky yarn:

 Sew two horizontal lines under the eyes for blush.
