Materials

Yarn (milk cotton or plush yarn) Black, Purple

2.5-3.0 mm crochet hook

Fiberfill stuffing

Yarn needle

Scissors

Stitch markers (optional)

Use bigger yarn & hook to make him bigger or smaller yarn & hook to make him smaller ^o^

Ghost Body (White Yarn)

R1. MR 6 sc

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3. (sc, inc) * 6 (18)

R4. (sc, inc, sc) * 6 (24)

R5. (3 sc, inc) * 6 (30)

R6–R10. 30 sc

R11. FLO (3 sc, dec) *6 (24)

R12. (sc, dec, sc) *6 (18)

R13. (sc, dec) *6 (12), stuff the body

R11. BLO 30 sc

R12. 30 hdc

R13. (hdc, dc, dc, hdc, sl st) *6 (to form wavy hem)

Arms (Make 2)

ch 5

Starting from the 2nd chain from the hook: 4 sc

(Fast and simple flat arms)

Witch Hat (Black Yarn)

R1. MR 4 sc

R2. sc, inc (6)

R3. 2 sc, inc (8)

R4. 8 sc

R5. (3 sc, inc)*2 (10)

R6. (4 sc, inc)*2 (12)

R7. 12 sc

R8. (5 sc, inc)*2 (14)

R9. 6 sc, inc → (16)

R10. 16 sc

R11. (sc, inc)*8 (24)

~~R12. 24 sc~~

R13. 24 inc (48)

R14. (3 sc, inc) *12 → (60)

Use pumpkin-colored yarn to embroider/edge the top part around R12.

Center Pumpkin

R1. MR 6 sc

R2. 6 inc (12)

R3. (sc, inc) * 6 (18)

R4. (sc, inc, sc) * 6 (24)

R5. (3 sc, inc) * 6 (30)

R6. (2 sc, inc, 2 sc) * 6 (36)

R7. (5 sc, inc) * 6 (42)

R8. (3 sc, inc, 3 sc) * 6 (48)

R9–R13. 48 sc

R14. (3 sc, dec, 3 sc) * 6 (42)

R15. (5 sc, dec) * 6 (36)

R16. (2 sc, dec, 2 sc) * 6 (30)

R17. (3 sc, dec) * 6 (24)

R18. (sc, dec, sc) * 6 (18), stuff the pumpkin

R19. (sc, dec) * 6 (12)

Finish: Leave a 60 cm tail.

Use yarn needle to sew and tighten the bottom into 6 sections (pumpkin shape).

Pumpkin Wings (Make 2 – Black Yarn)

◆ Left Wing: work all stitches in FLO (Front Loop Only)

◆ Right Wing: work all stitches in BLO (Back Loop Only)

Wing Pattern:

R1: (Start in R2) ch 16

R2: From 2nd ch from hook: 3 sl st, 7 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R3: 11 sl st, ch 4, turn

R4: From 2nd ch: 3 sl st, 5 dc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R5: 10 sl st, ch 3, turn

R6: From 2nd ch: 2 sl st, 4 dc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R7: 9 sl st, ch 3, turn

R8: From 2nd ch: 2 sl st, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc, ch 1, turn

R9: 7 sl st, ch 3, turn

R10: From 2nd ch: 2 sl st, 2 hdc, 5 sc

R11: Work along the side edge: 3 reverse sc (crab stitch) to finish

Pumpkin Wings (Black Yarn)

- ◆ Left wing: crochet all in FLO (front loop only)
- ◆ Right wing: crochet all in BLO (back loop only)

 Instructions:

R2. ch 16

- From 2nd ch from hook:
- 3 sl st, 7 dc, 3 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R3. 11 sl st, ch 4, turn

R4. From 2nd ch from hook:

- 3 sl st, 5 dc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R5. 10 sl st, ch 3, turn

R6. From 2nd ch from hook:

- 2 sl st, 4 dc, 4 hdc, 2 sc, ch 1, turn

R7. 9 sl st, ch 3, turn

R8. From 2nd ch from hook:

- 2 sl st, 3 dc, 3 hdc, 3 sc, ch 1, turn

R9. 7 sl st, ch 3, turn

R10. From 2nd ch from hook:

- 2 sl st, 2 hdc, 5 sc

R11. Work along the edge:

- 3 reverse sc (crab stitch)

Bottom Pumpkin (Base Piece)

R1: ch 21

→ Starting from 2nd ch from hook: 20 hdc

R2–R9: Turn, 20 hdc each row (total 8 rows)

Assembly:

- Fold the rectangle in half lengthwise
- Slip stitch across to join the two edges together
- Do not cut the yarn
- Use yarn needle to sew one open end closed
- Turn inside out, stuff with fiberfill
- Weave the yarn through the other open side and close it up
 - Without cutting yarn (or using new strand), wrap the pumpkin into 7 segments, each 4 rows tall

Pumpkin Vines (Kaki Green Yarn)

Long vine: ch 36, from 2nd ch from hook: 35 sc

Short vine: ch 26, from 2nd ch from hook: 25 sc

Pumpkin Handle (Stem)

R1: MR, 4 sc

R2–R7: 4 sc in each round (total 6 rounds)

Pumpkin Leaf (Kaki Green Yarn)

R1–2: ch 10

→ From 3rd ch: 8 sc, ch 4

→ Continue: 8 sc, ch 1, turn

R3:

Skip 1 st, 7 sc

Into ch–4 space from previous row: (2 sc, ch 4, 2 sc)

6 sc, ch 1, turn

R4:

Skip 1 st, 7 sc

(2 sc, ch 4, 2 sc) in the next ch–4 loop

7 sc, ch 1, turn

R5:

Skip 1 st, 8 sc

(2 sc, ch 4, 2 sc)

7 sc, ch 1, turn

R6:

Skip 1 st, 8 sc

(2 sc, ch 4, 2 sc)

8 sc, ch 1, turn

R7:

Skip 1 st, 9 sc

In next ch–4 space: (5 sc), then 8 sc, ch 4

R8:

From 3rd ch: 7 sc

ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc into the base body, ch 1, turn

R9:

Skip 1 st, 8 sc, ch 4

R10:

From 3rd ch: 12 sc

ch 1, skip 1, 1 sc into the body again, ch 1, turn

R11:

Skip 1 st, 10 sc

FO (Fasten Off) and cut yarn

Assembly & Finishing Instructions

Ghost (Top):

Sew the witch hat onto the top of the white ghost's head.

Attach both arms to the sides of the body.

Glue on safety eyes (or embroider if preferred).

Use black thread to embroider a smiling mouth.

Apply pink blush on the cheeks using thread, fabric marker, or cosmetic blush.

Center Pumpkin (Middle):

Sew both pumpkin wings (left and right) to the back of the pumpkin.

Use black thread to embroider a face:

- Eyes in a “><” shape
- Mouth below the eyes

Bottom Pumpkin (Base):

Attach the pumpkin leaf, stem, and two pumpkin vines to the top of the pumpkin base.

Stack the three parts in order:

Ghost → Center Pumpkin → Bottom Pumpkin

Final Assembly:

Join the three parts by either:

- Sewing them together with matching yarn
- Or using hot glue for a clean finish
