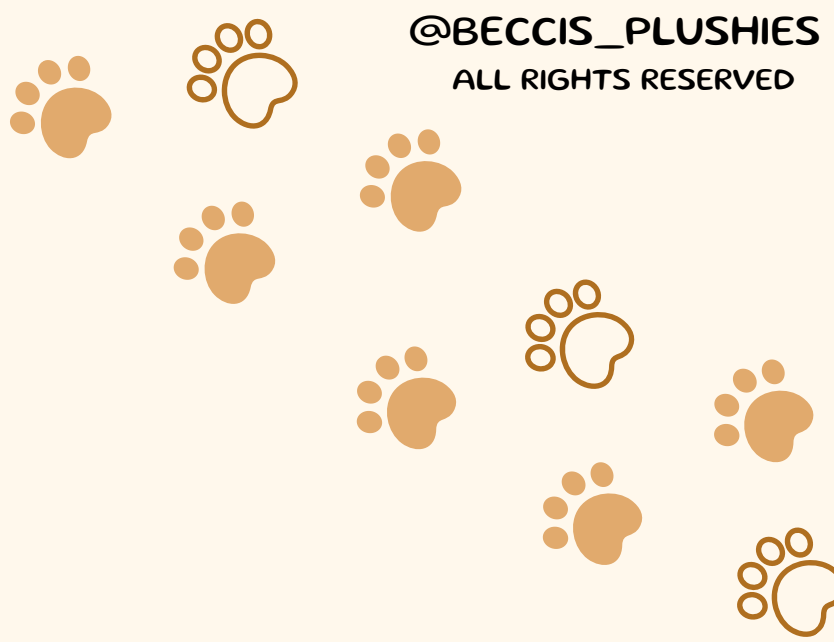


Fluffy Loaf Pug

O2 ABBREVIATIONS:

- BLO: BACK LOOP ONLY
- CC: COLOR CHANGE
- CH: CHAIN
- DC: DOUBLE CROCHET
- DEC: DECREASE
- F/O: FASTEN OFF
- HDC: HALF DOUBLE CROCHET
- INC: INCREASE
- MR: MAGIC RING
- R: ROUND
- SC: SINGLE CROCHET
- SLST: SLIP STITCH
- ST: STITCH



O3 MATERIALS

- SUGGESTED YARN:
(#3 DK LIGHT WORSTED FLUFFY YARN)
Frida's #17
 - dark brown
 - beige
- 3MM CROCHET HOOK
- BLACK ACRYLIC YARN FOR NOSE
- TAPESTRY NEEDLE
- SCISSORS
- STUFFING
- STITCH MARKER
- 8MM SAFETY EYES
(or whatever size you prefer)
- OPTIONAL: FABRIC GLUE



BODY / HEAD

with beige yarn

we'll start with the bottom and work our way up to the head

R1: 8sc in MR (8)

R2: inc x8 (16)

R3: (sc, inc) x8 (24)

R4: (2sc, inc) x8 (32)

R5: (3sc, inc) x8 (40)

R6-R22: sc around ***17 ROUNDS*** (40)

R23: (3sc, dec) x8 (32)

R24: (2sc, dec) x8 (24)

***stuff firmly but make sure to not
over stuff the bottom, shape your pug into a loaf***

R25: (sc, dec) x8 (16)

place safety eyes between R23 & R24, on each side of the head

R26: dec x8 (8)

F/O and sew the hole closed.



SNOUT

with dark brown yarn

Make a slipknot and ch6, *start in 2nd ch from hook*

R1: inc, 3sc, inc,

continue working on the other side of the ch

inc, 3sc, inc (14)

R2: 7sc, hdc, dc-inc, hdc, slst, hdc, dc-inc, hdc (16)

slst, F/O and leave a long tail for sewing OR weave in ends, if you want to glue the snout to the head.

- Sew/glue the snout to the middle of the head, directly between and one round under the eyes.
- Embroider nose in a 'T'-shape, starting on the top of the snout and bring down the vertical line to the bottom of the snout.



EARS *make 2*

with dark brown yarn

Insert your hook in a st on one side of the head, about 3-4st next to the eye, between R20 & R21 and pull up a loop,

ch5, ***start in the 2nd ch from hook***

make 4hdc and slst back into the head, 1st next to where you inserted. F/O and weave in ends.

repeat on other side of the head, about 9st next to the first ear



If your ear stands up like this,
you can sew the top of the
ear to the head



LEGS *make 4*

with beige yarn

R1: 8sc in MR (8)

R2: (sc, inc) x4 (12)

R3: sc around (12)

do not stuff the legs

F/O and leave a tail for sewing.

Sew the hind legs between R7 & R12, about 12st apart from each other.
Sew the front legs between R16 & R21, about 12st apart from each other.



TAIL

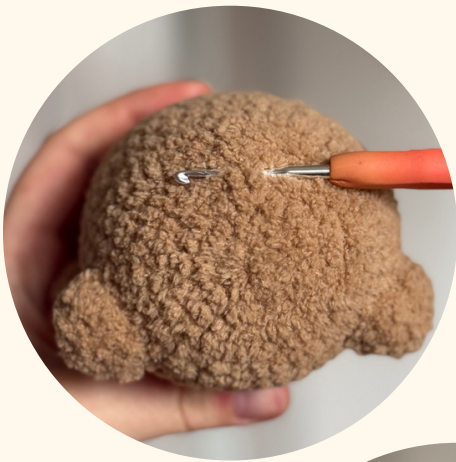
with beige yarn

Insert your hook in a st in the middle of the bottom between R4 & R5 and pull up a loop,

ch14, ***start in the 2nd ch from hook***

make 13slst down the ch, slst back into the body, F/O and weave in all ends.

Twist the tail until you have a cute curly tail.
